NOW NINOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAS GIVEN AN D GRANTED, and by these presents BOES GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said claimant and to the heirs of the said claimant the tract above described TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said claimant and to the heirs and assig s of the said claimant forever; subject to any vestes and accrued water rights for mining, agriculture, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water tights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local custom laws, and decisions of courts; and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or camals constructed by the authority of the United States.
