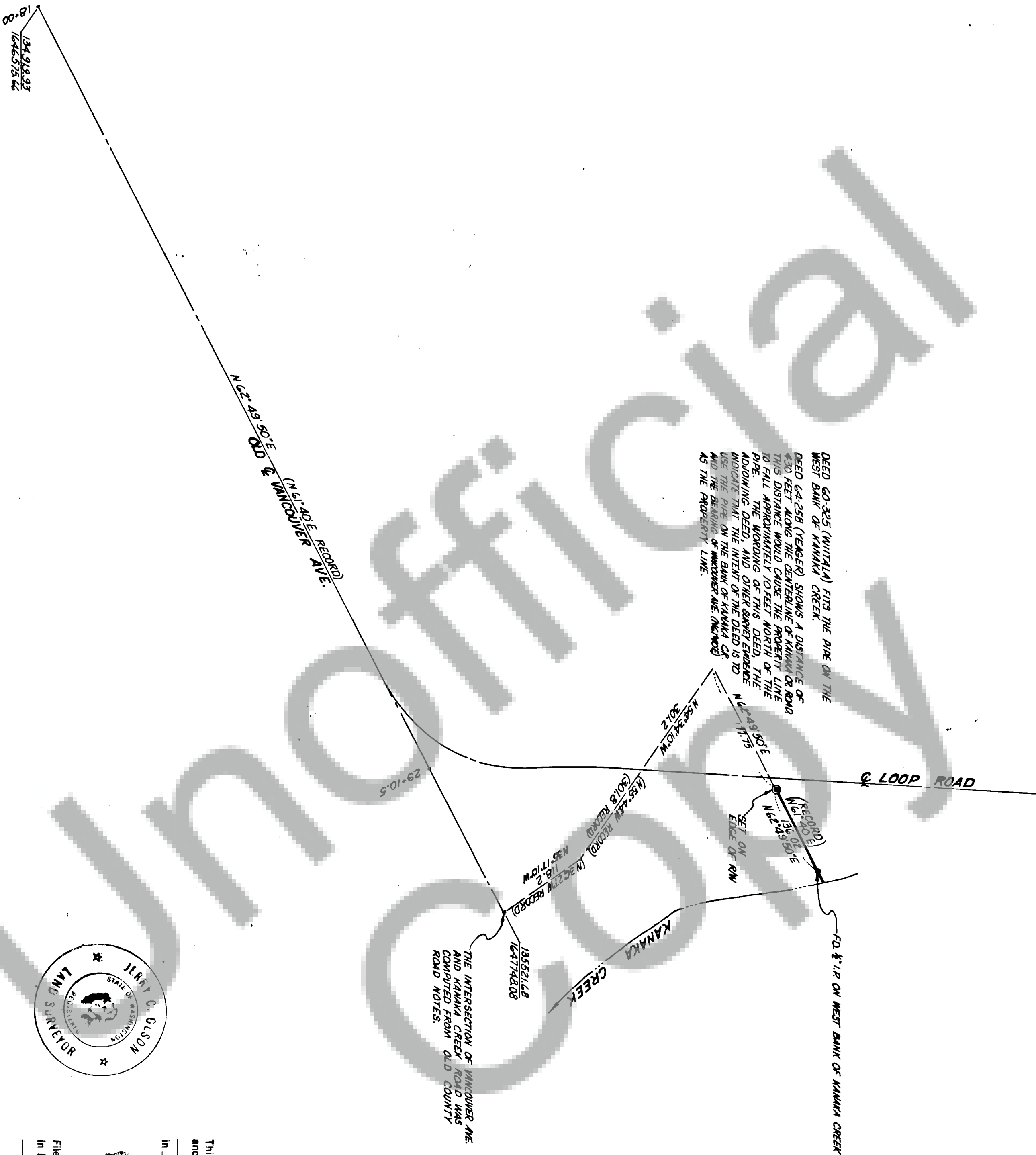


SURVEY OF

DEED GO-325 (WITTED) FITS THE PIPE ON THE
WEST BANK OF KANAKA CREEK.
DEED 64-258 (YEMER) SHOWS A DISTANCE OF
430 FEET ALONG THE CENTERLINE OF KANAKA CREEK
TO FALL APPROXIMATELY 10 FEET NORTH OF THE
PIPE. THE WOUNDING OF THIS DEED, THE
ADJOINING DEED, AND OTHER SURVEY EVIDENCE
INDICATE THAT THE INTENT OF THE DEED IS TO
USE THE PIPE ON THE BANK OF KANAKA CREEK
AS THE BEGINNING OF VANCOUVER AVE. (RECORDED)
AS THE PROPERTY LINE.
