

FIELD NOTES: A survey for the Washington State Department of General

Administration of a tract of land in the Southeast 1/4 of Section 4, Township 2 North, Range 6 East, Willamette

Meridian, Skamania County, Washington.

On October 24, 1975, Mr. Robert V. Reeves of the Washington State Department of General Administration retained our firm to survey a tract of land in the Southeast 1/4 of Section 4, Township 2 North, Range 6 East, Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington. The purpose of this survey was to establish the boundaries of a communications microwave site.

On July 9, 1976, we started the survey by surveying the perimeter of the site and setting corners at the required distances, the approximate location of which had been previously marked by Mr. Reeves.

A traverse was run on an existing access road across the site. This road provides access to Bonneville Power Administration McNary-Ross transmission line.

A tie was made to the Bonneville Power Administration McNary-Ross transmission line as a basis for bearings. This tie was also used to compute the location of section corners.

Corners found and established in the course of the above survey, together with measured bearings, distances, and ties, are shown on the attached map, Tenneson Engineering Corporation Work Order No. 5215, which by reference is made a part hereof.
