AALVIK, a widow have/has granted, bargained, and sold and by these presents do/does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA and its assigns all the bounded and described real property situate in the County of Skamania in the State of Washington as shown on Schedule "A" attached hereto and made part hereof.

Subject only to rights outstanding in third parties and reservations, as shown on Schedule "B" attached hereto and made part hereof together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described and granted premises unto the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA and its assigns, forever. I do covenant to and with the above named grantee and its assigns that I am lawfully seized and possessed of the above granted premises in fee; have a good and lawful right and power to sell and convey the same; that the same are free and clear of all encumbrances except as above noted, and that I will and my heirs, executors and administrators, shall warrant and forever defend the above granted premises, and every part and parcel thereof, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.

AND FURTHER, for the consideration aforesaid, I the grantor(s) above named hereby convey(s) and quitclaim unto the said UNITED STATES OF AMERICA and its assigns, all right, title and interest which I may have in and to the banks, beds and waters of any streams opposite to or fronting upon the lands above described and in any alleys, roads, streets, ways, strips, gores or railroad rights-of-way abutting or adjoining said land and in any means of ingress or egress appurtenant thereto.

THIS DEED, has been reexecuted and is being rerecorded to show the correct monetary consideration. The consideration shown on the original deed recorded on 25 May 1977 in Book 72 of Deeds at page 726, Records of Skamania County, Washington failed to compensate the grantor herein for loss of access to State Highway No. 14.



Beginning at the intersection of the Northerly right-of-way line of the Evergreen Highway (State Highway No. 14) with the East line of the G. W. Johnson Donation Land Claim No. 38; thence Southwesterly along said right-of-way 69.21 feet; thence North $37^{\circ}05'42''$ West 101.66 feet; thence on an arc of a 175.00 foot radius curve to the left through an angle of $23^{\circ}52'10''$ a distance of 72.91 feet; thence North $60^{\circ}57'52''$ West 57.82 feet; thence on an arc of a 145.00 foot radius curve to the right through an angle of $46^{\circ}56'26''$ to the intersection with a line which is 33.00 feet Southerly, as measured at right angles from and perpendicular to the Southerly line of a 100.00 foot transmission line easement granted to the United States of America by deed dated January 19, 1942 and recorded at page 585 of book 28 of Deeds, Records of Skamania County, Washington; thence Southeasterly along aforesaid line to the intersection of the Easterly line of said D.L.C.; thence Southerly along said D.L.C. line to the point of beginning.
