This certifies that the tracts of land described in the foregoing list have been carefully examined and compared with the township plats and tract books in this office, and the same have been found to agree with the State of Washington for the purpose stated, being free from conflicts or other adverse claims of record. No withdrawal or reservation is of record in this office affecting any of the selected lands. Reports have been received from the Geological Survey stating that the records of the Survey indicate that in all probability the lands contain no coal or other non-metalliferous minerals but that they may contain metalliferous deposits. Field examination was recommended to determine whether metalliferous deposits are to be found in the lands. April 4, 1925, a departmental inspector submitted reports, based on field examination, stating that such field examination disclosed no mineralization. We recommended that the lands be given a non-mineral classification. These reports have been accepted by this office.

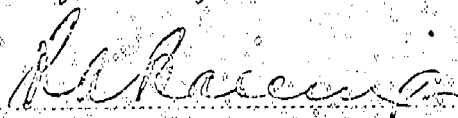

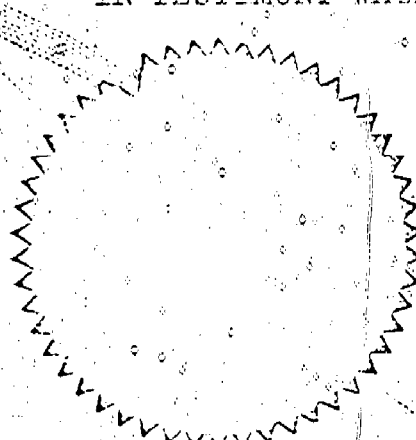

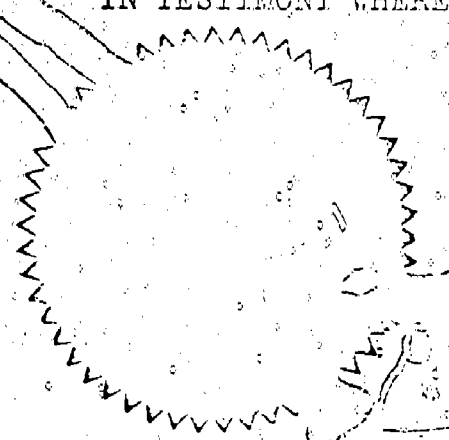
