QUITCLAIM DEED

THE GRANTOR, the United States of America, acting by and through the undersigned, pursuant to the authority of Section 83 of the Act of Congress approved 7 March 1974 (Public Law 93-251; 88 Stat. 35); and the delegation of authority from the Secretary of the Army dated 20 July 1977, and recorded in Volume 73 of Deeds, Page 126 under Skamania County File No. 84516, Records of Skamania County, Washington; and the redelegation of authority from the Acting Director of Real Estate, Office of the Chief of Engineers, dated 25 July 1977, recorded in Volume 73 of Deeds, Page 127, under Skamania County File No. 84516, Records of Skamania County, Washington; for the relocation of the City of North Bonneville, Washington, and in satisfaction of the obligations, of the Government imposed by Article 5 of Relocation Contract No. DACW57-76-C-0039 dated 19 August 1975, for and in consideration of Four Thousand Six Hundred Eighty-Two and 10/100 Dollars----- (\$4,682.10), hereby conveys and quitclaims to The Port of Skamania County, a municipal corporation of the State of Washington all of its right, title and interest in the following described real property situated in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to wit: Lot I-4 in the Fifth Addition to the Plats of Relocated North Bonneville recorded in Volume B of Plat Records, Pages 51 and 52, Skamania County Auditor's File No. 94016.

This Deed conveys no right of access to Washington State Highway No. 14.

Reserving to the United States of America the right to grant easements to public utilities to erect, construct, operate and maintain public utility facilities on, over and under the utility easement(s), if any, as shown on said recorded plats.

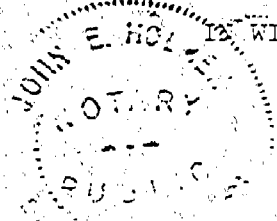
