By an examination of the above described premises on September 28, 1982, Grantor herein (Weyerhaeuser Company) concluded that all timber intended to be conveyed under the above described deed has been removed and that all rights under said deed have therefore terminated.

THEREFORE, Grantor convenants with Grantee herein to indemnify Grantee against any and all losses, up to the value of the above described tract as established by Grantee for this exchange of properties, arising from anyone claiming rights under the Deed described above.

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FURTHER, Grantor agrees to obtain and provide to Grantee within five (5) years of the date of this DEED, a release in recordable form of any rights granted to Carl E. Forsberg and Evelyn D. Forsberg, heirs and assigns, under the DEED described above.

Should GRANTOR be unable to obtain the required release of timber rights within five years of the date of this DEED, upon receipt of request by Grantee, Grantor shall convey to Grantee a parcel of forest land mutually agreeable to Grantor and Grantee and equivalent in value, in exchange for Government Lots 7 and 8, Section 39, Township 7 North, Range 5 East, W.M. being reconveyed by Grantee herein.

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
