

BEGINNING at the Southeasterly corner of the said Lot 50, said point being common with the Southwesterly corner of Lot 49 of Washougal Riverside Tract aforesaid; thence along the Easterly line of the said Lot 50 Northwesterly 148 feet; thence parallel to the Northerly line of the said Lot 50 Southwesterly, 110 feet; thence parallel to the Easterly line of the said Lot 50 Southeasterly 250 feet, more or less, to the Southerly line of the said Lot 50; thence along said Southerly line Northerly to the point of beginning.

EXCEPT the Easterly 10 feet thereof.

TOGETHER WITH a 5 foot right of way and easement on the Southerly 5 feet of the Northerly 25 feet of Lot 11, Washougal Riverside Tracts as described in Book Y, page 236, deed records of Skamania County, Washington, said 5 foot right of way to be a perpetual easement from the road to center of the river for ingress and egress and the right to build and maintain steps thereon. BEGINNING at the Southeasterly corner of the said Lot 50, said point being common with the Southwesterly corner of Lot 49 of Washougas Riverside Tracts aforesaid; thence along the Easterly line of the said Lot 50 Northwesterly 148 feet; thence parallel to the Northerly line of the said Lot 50 Southwesterly 110 feet to the Northwesterly corner of the tract conveyed to John Oyala by instrument recorded July 11, 1973 at page 78-479 in Book 65 of Deeds, records of Skamania County, Washington, under Auditor's File No. 76334, said Northwesterly corner being the true point of beginning; thence from said point of beginning. Southwesterly parallel with the Northerly line of said Lot 50, a distance of 8 feet; thence parallel to the Easterly line of the said Lot 50, Southeasterly 250 feet, more or less, to the Southerly line of the said Lot 50; thence along said Southerly line Northerly to the most Southerly corner of said Oyala tract; thence Northwesterly along the Southwest boundary of said Oyala tract 250 feet, more or less, to the true point of beginning.
