EASEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, Department of Energy, Bonneville Power Administration (BPA), does hereby grant unto the STATE OF WASHINGTON, acting by and through its DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, and its assigns (hereinafter called the Grantee), an easement for two 40 feet in width existing roads for access purposes for the continued management, including timber removal, administration, and utilization of State-owned lands over, upon, and across portions of Tract Nos. BV-36, BV-37, and BV-58 of BPA's fee-owned 300-foot-wide North Bonneville-Troutdale Nos. 1 and 2 (formerly Bonneville-Vancouver) transmission line right-of-way acquired in fee by Declarations of Taking No. 26, dated December 20; 1938 (BV-36 and BV-37), and No. 29, dated January 5, 1939 (BV-58), on record in the District Court of the United States for the Western District of Washington, Southern Division. The roads are located as follows:

Tract Nos. BV-36 and BV-37: In the SW\(\frac{1}{2}\)SW\(\frac{1}{2}\) of Section 25, and the \(\frac{1}{2}\)SE\(\frac{1}{2}\)SE\(\frac{1}{2}\) of Section 26, Township 2 North, Range 5 East, Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington, and as shown on the attached portion of BPA Drawing No. 3372, marked Exhibit A.

Tract No. BV-58: In the N2NE2 of Section 27, Township 2 North, Range 4 East, Willamette Meridian, Clark County, Washington, and as shown on the attached portion of BPA Drawing No. 3392, marked Exhibit B.

Subject to outstanding rights.

This easement shall not interfere with any use by the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

The roads shall be maintained at all times in as good condition as existed prior to Grantee's use.

If this easement should ever be terminated, the roads shall be left in as good a condition as when Grantee's use began.

There shall be a minimum clearance of 50 feet between the nearest tower leg and the closest edge of the roads to the tower in order to maintain a safe working distance.

Reserving unto the United States and its assigns the right to maintain existing electric transmission lines and facilities, and to erect and maintain future transmission lines and facilities over and across the said property.

Reserving the right of access to BPA's fee-owned property at all times.

Reserving also unto the United States and its assigns the right to use the roads and to construct, operate, and maintain such approaches to the roads as the United States may consider necessary or convenient to the construction, operation, and maintenance of its facilities.

The Grantee, and its assigns, shall be liable for any damage to the property of the United States including transmission lines and structures arising out of or resulting from negligent acts of said Grantee's employees, agents, or assigns acting within their authority in the use and maintenance of said existing roads upon the property of the United States.

Should the rights granted herein no longer be used or needed for road purposes for a consecutive two-year period, or abandoment thereof, and upon written notice by the United States to the STATE OF WASHINGTON, DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, or its assigns, all rights granted by this easement shall automatically terminate and the title thereto revest in the United States and its assigns.

This conveyance is issued without monetary consideration

This conveyance is made pursuant to the Acts of August 20, 1937, (50 Stat. 732, 16 U.S.C. § 832a), as amended, and October 23, 1962 (76 Stat. 1129, 40 U.S.C. § 319) and regulations and delegations of authority issued pursuant thereto, it having been determined that the granting of the easement shall not be adverse to the interests of the United States.
