- (1) Reserving to the Government the right to grant easements for certain utilities constructed or to be constructed under Relocation Contracts

  DACW57-76-C-0264, DACW57-76-C-0265 and DACW57-77-C-0167, on record in the office of the District Engineer, Portland, Oregon, 319 Southwest Pine Street, Portland, Oregon 97204.
- (2) The right is hereby reserved to the Government, its officers, agents and employees to enter upon, and to grant rights to others to enter upon, said areas covered by this right-of-entry at any time when deemed necessary for the protection of the interests of the Government, and the City shall not have any claim of any character on account thereof against the Government or any officer, agent or employee thereof.
- (3) The Government shall not be responsible for damages to property or injuries to persons which may arise from or be incident to the exercise of the privileges herein granted, or for damages to the property of the grantee, or for damages to the property or injuries to the person of the grantee's officers, agents, servants, or employees, or others who may be on said premises at their invitation or the invitation of any one of them, arising from or incident to governmental activities on or in the vicinity of the said premises, and the grantee shall hold the Government harmless from any and all such claims.
- (4) Any property of the Government damaged or destroyed shall be promptly repaired or replaced by the City to the satisfaction of the Government or in

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lieu of such repair or replacement, the City shall, if so required by the Government and at the Government's option, pay to the Government money in an amount sufficient to compensate for the loss sustained by the Government by reason of damage to or destruction of Government property.

(5) It is understood that this right-of-entry is effective only insofar as the property rights of the Government in the lands involved are concerned and it does not relieve the City from the necessity of obtaining grants from the owners of the fee and or other interests therein.
