The Grantor, SKAMANIA COUNTY, a municipal corporation for good and valuable consideration, in hand paid, does hereby convey and quit-claim to THE COLUMBIA GORGE INTERPRETIVE CENTER, a non-profit corporation, the following described real property being situated in Skamania County, State of Washington,, together with all tenements and appurtenances and after acquired title thereto:

Parcel #1 Beginning at the Skamania County brass monument marking the northwest corner of Section 1, township 2 North, Range 7 East W.M., thence south along the west line of said section 2550.0 feet to the point of beginning; thence east 410.0 feet more or less to the 75-foot water line of the Bonneville Tidal Pool; thence southerly along the 75-foot water line to the north right-of-way of State Highway 14; thence westerly along the north right-of-way to the south-easter corner of the state highway maintenance site property; thence northerly along the east line of said property 135 feet; thence westerly along the north line of said property 537 feet; thence southwesterly along the west line of said property to the north right-of-way of State Highway 14; thence west along the north right-of-way line to the east right-of-way of Second Street Extension; thence northeasterly along the east right-of-way of Second Street to a point approximately 30 feet west of the point of beginning; thence east to the point of beginning.

Parcel #2 The following property located in Sections 1 and 2, Township 2 North, Range 7 East W.M..

More specifically, all that property lying southerly of the division line between the northerly and southerly parts of the Baughman Donation Land Claim, and northerly of the north right-of-way line of State Highway 14, and easterly of the east right-of-way line of Second Street Extension, which includes Parcel #1 above described.

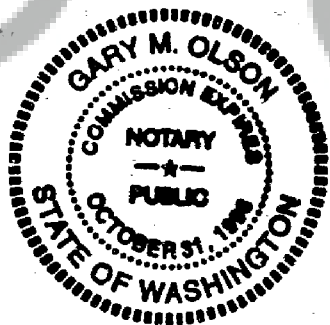
