Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person Fable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay as any person sable to pay any tax neglects or retuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (notified any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a Sen in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the ten imposed by section 6323 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the Sabitry for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the 'tarpayer arising out of such fiability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—Tre Ber Emposed by section 8321 shall not be valid as against any burchase, holder of a security interest, mechanic's tenor, or judyment lien craditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been field by the Secretary.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or partnership shall be diemed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the business is located, and the residence of a taxpayor whose residence is without the United States shall be deemed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary, Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of tien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien.—Subject to such requlations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of refusee of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the Sability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or

has become legally unerforceable; or
(2) Bond Accepted-There is furnished to the Se-cretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount accessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any endersion of such Sme), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereon, as may be specified by such relations.
