NOTICE HEREBY IS GIVEN that the undersigned locators, each a citizen of the United States or one who has declared an intention to become such, have discovered a vein or lode of locatable mineral-bearing rock in place upon the public domain of the United States which is open to mineral entry and location within the above state, county and mining district; and, in accordance with the laws of the United States and of the State of Oregon, have located and do hereby locate a claim upon such vein or lode by posting this notice of such discovery and location on a substantial post or monument at the point of discovery. The name of the claim is:

SOMETIMES SUNNY

Claim, further described as follows:

Commencing at a post marked No. 1 then:

1400 feet in a NW
1400 feet in a SW
1400 feet in a SE
1400 feet in a NE

direction to a corner post marked No. 2, then
direction to a corner post marked No. 3, then
direction to a corner post marked No. 4, then
direction to said corner post marked No. 1.

The locators claim

direction from the point of discovery to the WEST
feet in the opposite direction from the point of discovery to the SOUTH

feet in a EAST
end line and 1400

feet on each side of the middle of said vein or lode, further claiming all the surface rights, privileges and minerals, with all dips, spurs, angles and variations, and other rights granted by existing laws and customs. This claim is further described as being 700 feet from the following natural object or permanent monument in the vicinity: Center of old creek meet.

The general course or strike of the vein or lode as nearly as may be determined is gold bearing quartz with reference to the natural object or permanent monument described above.

This claim is situated in the NE 1/4 (designate quarter section) of Section 13 Township 4 N Range 5 E 1/4 of the Willamette Meridian, as surveyed by the U.S. Government or protracted if the land is unsurveyed.

The end lines of the claim are parallel to each other. The adjoining claims are parallel to each other.

This notice is placed conspicuously at the discovery post, and posts are placed at each corner of the claim. The location of this claim is distinctly marked on the ground so that the boundaries of the claim may be readily traced.
