COMMUNITY PROPERTY AGREEMENT

THIS COMMUNITY PROPERTY AGREEMENT, entered into this day by and between WALTER I. LONG and FRANCES M. LONG, husband and wife, of Skamania County, State of Washington,

W I T N E S S E T H :

WHEREAS, the parties hereto are the owners of certain real and personal property situate in the State of Washington; and

WHEREAS, it is contemplated by the parties hereto that they may acquire additional property in the future; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire hereto that all of their property shall pass to the survivor without delay or expense in the event of the death of either party;

NOW, THEREFORE, WE, WALTER I. LONG and FRANCES M. LONG, husband and wife, for and in consideration of the love and affection which we have, one of for the other, do hereby mutually agree that all of the property which we now own separately, jointly, or otherwise, and whether real, personal or otherwise, and wheresoever situate, shall be and it is hereby declared to be the community property of the parties, and each of the parties do hereby convey and transfer to the other party and to their community, all property owned by them, even though the same be held in his or her separate estate; and

WE HEREBY MUTUALLY AGREE that all of the property which shall hereafter be acquired by either of us, whether separately, jointly, or otherwise, and of whatsoever nature, and wheresoever situate, shall be and it is hereby declared to be the community property, and each of the parties do hereby convey and transfer to the other and to their community, all such property hereafter acquired by either of them, even though the same be acquired in his or her separate estate; and

LONG, while the said FRANCES M. LONG survives, be vested in FRANCES M. LONG, absolutely and in fee simple as her sole and separate property; and in the event of the death of the said FRANCES M. LONG, while the said WALTER I. LONG survives, then the whole of the community property now owned by us or hereafter acquired by us, including all property the status of which is changed or created by this agreement, shall at once vest in the said WALTER I. LONG, absolutely and in fee simple as his sole and separate property.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have executed this agreement this 18<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1982.

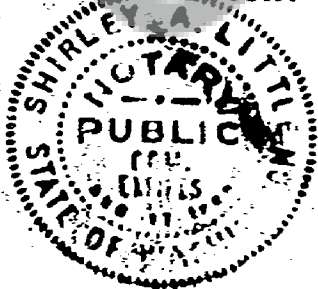
