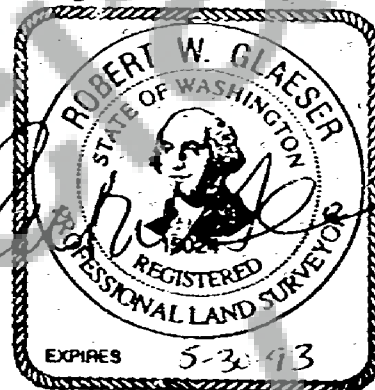

(1) Pertinent Corner History:

The original survey was conducted by Deputy Surveyors Lewis  
VanVleet and John Newsom, under Contract No. 7, dated April 23,  
1859. The survey was performed between April 29, and 30, 1859.  
Set a post 40.00 chains East from the Southwest corner of Section  
33.

B.T.'s were as follows:

12" Diam. Maple, North 45° East, 14 Links

30" Diam. Fir, South 45° West, 39 Links

A resurvey was conducted by Deputy Surveyor Charles E. Sears, under  
Contract No. 287, dated December 23, 1882. The survey was  
performed between March 16 and June 26, 1883. They found remains  
of the quarter corner post in the ground and the bearing trees were  
standing. Therefore a new post, 3 feet long and 3 inches square  
was set 24 inches into the ground, 40 chains East from the  
Southwest corner of Section 33.

B.T.'s were as follows:

12" Diam. Maple, North 45° 14 Links

30" Diam. Fir, South 45 West, 39 Links

(2) Evidence Found at the Corner:

No original evidence was found. Skamania County brass cap was  
accepted as the corner based on reputation and use.

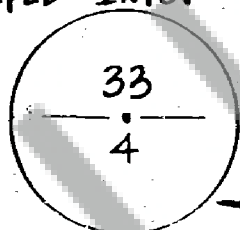
