# **Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code**

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#### Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay If any person some to pay any tax regrets or crises to go the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or essessable penalty, adapther with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto; shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to

#### Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by faw, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the flability for the amount so seessed (or a Judgment sgainst the texpays arising out of such fieldility) is satisfied or becomes unenforce. able by reason of lapse of time

### Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Cértain Persons.

(a Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The Sen Imposed by section 6321 shall not be yaild as against any purchase, holder of a security interest, mechanic's Senor, or judgment lien creditor until statice shared which meats the requires of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

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(B) Personal Property in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intengible, of the residence of the tampayer at time the notice of lien is bled.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or partnership shall be deemed to be the place at which she principal executive office of the business is located, and the residence of a taxpayer whose residence is without the United States shall be deerived to be in the District of Columbia.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

**M Disclosure of Certain Returns** and Return information For Tax Administration Purposes.-

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lies, if a notice of lies has been thed pursuant to section \$323(f), she amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lies may be disclosed to any person, who furnishes settletectory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lies or intende to obtain a right in euch property.
