That this Affidavit is made for the purpose of supplying information of record pertaining to that certain Community Property Agreement executed by John W. Butler and LaRena V. Butler, husband and wife, dated November 10, 1962, and recorded in the Office of the Auditor of Skamania County, Washington, on December 3, 1962 as Document No. 60802; that the information set forth in this Affidavit may be relied upon by any person in dealing with property, real or personal, the title to which is deraigned through said Community Property Agreement.

- 1. That John W. Butler died on or about the 15th day of May, 1983, in Portland, Oregon, being, at the time of his death, a resident of Clark County, Washington.
