A DEPENDENT SURVEY of the  
NE 1/4 OF SECTION 33, T2N R5E, W.M.,  
for JOE ZUMSTEIN, JR.  
situated within  
SKAMANIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON

NARRATIVE

The purpose of this survey was to monument the tracts conveyed to Zumstein. In Record of Survey, dated 5-72, for Dean Burk the North line of Section 33 was ran. The North 1/4 corner was not found and was calculated at the single proportion position. The Burk tract was then monumented perpendicular to and parallel with the North line of Section 33. In a second survey for Priddle, see Record of Survey recorded in book 1 at page 64 the Burk survey was used as the basis to establish the Priddle Property corners. The second survey also noted the subdivision lines as perpendicular to the North Section line.

In Record of Survey recorded in book 1 at page 234, Section 33 was surveyed. The exterior corners around the section were visited and the Section was subdivided. The survey in book 1 page 234 notes the North 1/4 corner as being set from original BT's, and not lost as noted in the Burk survey. The subsequent surveys in Section 33 have relied upon or used as a basis the survey recorded in book 1 at page 234.

This survey is also based on the survey recorded in book 1 page 234.

The Center Line of Washougal River Road (Salmon Falls) is based on found Skamania County monuments, see County road Project 62-4.
