Co-petitioners state:

We, Edward Dennis Bustya and Katherine Dean Bustya agree to the joint legal custody of our child, Sierra born March 18, 1989.

We agree to share the rights and responsibilities for major decisions concerning the child, including but not limited to, the child's education, health care and religious training.

We agree that Katherine Dean Bustya shall have physical custody of Sierra Bustya.

We agree to share the responsibility for the support of the child.

We agree that Edward Dennis Bustya shall pay Katherine Dean Bustya \$350.00 per month as and for child support until she reaches the age of 18, is otherwise emancipated by marriage or voluntary entry into the military. Said support shall continue until age 21 so long as the child is a student attending school as defined by Oregon law. In addition, Edward shall pay for one-half of all major expenses for Sierra.

We agree that visitation with Edward shall be two nights

1 during the week and two weekends per month. All times
2 and days shall be mutually arranged between parents. Holidays
3 shall be mutually arranged between parents. Mother shall have
4 Sierra for a two week period over Christmas. Father shall have
5 Sierra for a four day period over Thanksgiving. Any other times
6 shall be mutually agreed upon.

7 We agree to adhere to this schedule unless both parties agree
8 to change their holiday time.

9 We agree that neither parent acting alone shall do any act to
10 deprive the other parent of physical custody for a period of
11 more than 14 days, nor take the child out of this state
12 without the written consent of the other parent.

13 We agree that if either parent should decide to relocate more
14 than 75 miles from the city of Portland, we shall work out a
15 mutually agreed upon visitation and custody schedule. We agree
16 that if we cannot come to an acceptable agreement on our own we
17 shall obtain a mediator and abide by the decision made in
18 mediation. This decision will be based on what is best for Sierra.
