

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That the undersigned who is/are (has declared intention to become) citizen of the United States, has discovered and has located and claimed and do hereby locate 1500 linear feet in length, and 800 feet in width on the 10th Township Range 6 Section 16. Lode, vein, ledge or deposit (or placer ground), situated in the above State, County (or Recording Precinct) and Mining District, and further described as follows: Commencing at a post marked No. 1 at the Discovery shaft (cut or tunnel), from thence 600 feet in a Northwestly direction to an end post marked No. 2, thence 1500 feet in a Southly direction to a corner post marked No. 3, thence 600 feet in a Eastly direction to a corner post marked No. 4, thence 1500 feet in a Northly direction to a corner post marked No. 5, thence 300 feet in a Westly direction to a corner post marked No. 6, thence 300 feet in a Westly direction to said end post No. 2; hereby locating and intending to claim 500 feet in a Northly direction from discovery to the North end line, and 400 feet in the opposite direction from discovery to the South end line and 300 feet on each side of the middle of said lode or ledge, for the purpose of mining the same and claiming all surface rights, privileges, and minerals, with all dips, spurs, angles and variations, and other rights granted by existing laws and customs.

This claim is further described by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, as follows: Approximately 2000 ft. in a South Westly direction from Ryan lake.


