DISCHARGE ORDER

It appearing that the person(s) named above has filed a petition commencing a case under title 11, United States code, that an order for relief was entered under Chapter 7 and that no complaint objecting to the discharge of the debtor(s) was filed within the time fixed by the Court [or that a complaint objecting to discharge of the debtor(s) was filed, and after due notice and hearing, was not sustained] it is ordered that:

1. The above named debtor(s) is released from all dischargeable debts.
2. Any judgment heretofore or hereafter obtained in any court other than this court is null and void as a determination of the personal liability of the debtor with respect to any of the following
 - a. debts dischargeable under 11 U.S.C. section 523;
 - ** b. unless heretofore or hereafter determined by order of this court to be non-dischargeable, debts alleged to be excepted from discharge under clauses (2), (4) and (6) of 11 U.S.C. section 523(a);
 - c. debts determined by this court to be discharged under 11 U.S.C. section 523(d).
3. All creditors whose debts are discharged by this order and all creditors whose judgments are declared null and void by paragraph 2 above, are enjoined from commencing, continuing or employing any action, process, or act to collect, recover, or offset any such debt as a personal liability of the debtor, or from property of the debtor, whether or not discharge of such debt is waived.
