1. That on July 13, 1994, Case No. MC622-1465, the

3. Removal to District Court is brought herein pursuant to RCW 69.50.505 wherein it provides for right of removal to the District Court if the value of the seized property is within that courts jurisdictional limits. This complaint for removal is being made within forty-five (45) days after the Petitioner notified the seizing law enforcement agency of the Petitioner's claim of the ownership or right to possession, as required by statute.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner prays for judgment against the Respondent as follows:

1. That certain items seized by the City of Ridgefield and/or Clark County/Skamania County Narcotics Task Force be ordered returned to the Petitioners.

2. That the Petitioners be awarded costs and reasonable attorney fees pursuant to RCW 69.50.505.

3. For such other and further relief as the court deems just and equitable.
