PARCEL B:

That portion of the E. C. Hardy Donation Land Claim No. 41, situated in Section, T. 2 N., R. 7 E.W.M., and of E. C. Hardy D.L.C. No. 38, situated in Section 25, T. 2 N., R. 6 E.W.M., described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the west line of the S.M.
