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DEED OF TRUST

THIS DEED OF TRUST IS DATED JANUARY 4, 1995, among BETTY JEAN DAUGHERTY, a widow, whose mailing address is P.O. BOX 1007/5991 LOOP ROAD, STEVENSON, WA 98648 (referred to below as "Grantor"); FIRST INDEPENDENT BANK, whose mailing address is PO BOX 340, STEVENSON, WA 98648-0340 (referred to below sometimes as "Lender" and sometimes as "Beneficiary"); and Skamania County Auditor, whose mailing address is PO Box 790 Stevenson, WA 98648 (referred to below as "Trustee").

CONVEYANCE AND GRART. For valuable consideration, Grantor conveys to Trustee in trust with power of sale, right of entry and possession and for the benefit of Lender as Beneficiary, at of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to the following discribed real property, together with all existing or subsequently erected or affect buildings, improvements and follows; all essements, rights of way, and appurtenances; all water, water rights and clich rights (including stock in utilities with clich or irrigation rights); and all other rights, reveltes, and profits relating to the real property, including without smilesion all minerals, oil, gas, geothermal and similar matters, located in SKANLANIA County, State of Washington (the "Real Property"):

A tract of land in the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 36, Township 3 North, Range 7 1/2 East of the Williamstle Meridian, in the County of Skamenia, State of Washington, described as follows:

Grantor hereby assigns as security to Lender, all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to all teases, Rents, and profits of the Property. This sesignment is recorded in accordance with RCW 66.08.070; the lien created by this assignment is intended to be specific, perfected and choses upon the recording of this Dead of Trust. Lender grants to Grantor a tounce to collect the Rents and profits, which iscense may be revoked at Lender's option and shall be automatically revoked upon acceleration of all or part of the Indebtudness.

DEFINITIONS. The following words shall have the following meanings when used in this Deed of Trust. Terms not otherwise defined in this Deed of Trust shall have the meanings attributed to such terms in the Uniform Commercial Code. All references to dollar amounts shall mean amounts in lawful money of the United States of America.

Beneficiary. The word "Beneficiary" means FIRST INDEPENDENT BANK, its successors and assigns. FIRST INDEPENDENT BANK also is referred to as "Lander" in this Deed of Trust.

Good of Trust. The words 'Daed of Trust' mean this Dead of Trust among Grantor, Lender, and Trustee, and Includes without fimitation all assignment and security interest provisions relating to the Personal Property and Rents.

Grantor. The word "Grantor" means any and all persons and entities seacuting this Deed of Trust, including without similation BETTY JEAN DAUGHERTY.

Guaranter. The word "Guaranter" means and includes without limitation any and all guaranters, sureties, and accommodation parties in connection with the indebtedness.

Improvements. The word "improvements" means and included without limitation all existing and future improvements, follures, buildings, structures, mobile homes allowed on the Real Property, facilities, additions, replacements and other construction on the Real Property.

Indebtedness. The word "Indebtedness" means all principal and interest payable under the Note and any amounts expended or advanced by Lender to discharge obligations of Grantor or expenses incurred by Trustee or Lender to enforce obligations of Grantor under this Deed of Trust, together with interest on such amounts as provided in this Deed of Trust.

Lander. The word "Lender" means FIRST INDEPENDENT BANK, its successors and assigns.

Note: The word "Note" means the Note deted January 4, 1995, in the original principal amount of \$16,000.00 from Grantor to Lender, together with all renewals, extensions, modifications, refinancings, and substitutions for the Note.

Personal Property. The words "Personal Property" mean all equipment, fixtures, and other articles of personal property now or hereafter owned by Grantor, and now or hereafter attached or affixed to the Real Property; together with all accessions, parts, and additions to, all replacements of, and all substitutions for, any of such property; and together with all issues and profits thereon and proceeds (including without limitation all insurance proceeds and refunds of premiums) from any sale or other disposition of the Property.

Property. The word "Property" means collectively the Real Property and the Personal Property.

Roal Property. The words "Rest Property" maen the property, interests and rights described above in the "Conveyance and Grant" section.

Related Decuments. The words "Related Documents" mean and include without similation at promisecry notes, credit agreements, loan agreements, environmental agreements, guarantee, security agreements, mortgages, deeds of trust, and all other instruments, agreements and documents, whether now or hereefer entelling, executed in connection with the indebtedness.

Flents. The word "Flents" means all present and future rents, revenues, income, issues, royalities, profits, and other benefits derived from the Property.

Trustee. The word "Trustee" meens Skamente County Auditor and any substitute or successor trustees.

ender's Plant to Enter. Lender and its agents and representatives may enter upon the Real Property at all reasonable times to attend to Lender's interests and to inspect the Property for purposes of Grantor's compliance with the terms and conditions of this Deed of Trust.

Compliance with Governmental Regularizations. Grantor shall promptly comply, and shall promptly cause compliance by all agents, tenants or other persons or entities of every return whichoever who rent, lesse or otherwise use or occupy the Property in any menner, with all laws, ordinances, and regulations, now or hereafter in effect, of all governmental authorities applicable to the use or occupancy of the Property. Grantor may contest in good talth any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, long as Grantor has notified Lander in writing prior to doing so and so long as, in Lander's sole opinion, Lander's kriterasis in the Property are not inoperdized. Lender may require Grantor to post eduquate security or a surety bond, reasonably satisfactory to Lander, to protect Lender's

Duly to Protect. Grantor agrees neither to abandon nor leave unattended the Property. Grantor shall do all other acts, in addition to those acts set forth above in this section, which from the character and use of the Property are reasonably necessary to protect and preserve the Property.

DUE ON SALE — COMMENT BY LENDER. Lender may, at its option, (a) declare immediately due and payable all sums secured by this Deed of Trust or (b) increase the interest rate provided for in the Note or other document evidencing the Indebtedness and impose such other conditions as Lender deems appropriate, upon the sale or transfer, without the Lender's prior written consent, of all or any part of the Real Property, or any interest in the Real Property. A "sale or transfer" means the correspondence of Real Property or any right, title or interest therein; whether legal, beneficial or equitable; whother voluntary or involuntary; whether by outright sale, deed, installment sale contract, innd contract, contract for deed, leasehold interest with a term greater than three (3) years, lease-option contract, or by sale, assignment, or transfer of any beneficial interest in or to any land trust holding title to the Real Property, or by any other method of conveyance of Real Property interest. It any Grantor is a corporation, partnership or limited liability company, transfer also includes any change in correspond or more than hearty-like nearcard (25%) of the volino stock, partnership interests or limited company, transfer also includes any change in ownership of more than twenty-five percent (25%) of the voting stock, partnership interests or limited liability company interests, as the case may be, of Granfor. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if such exercise is prohibited by federal law or by Washington law,

TAXES AND LIENS. The idiativing provisions relating to the taxes and liens on the Property are a part of this Deed of Trust.

Payment. Granter shall pay when due (and in all events prior to delinquency) all laxes, special laxes, sessements, charges (including water and sewer), fines and impositions levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for work done on or for services rendered or meterial furnished to the Property. Grantor shall maintain the Property free of all liens having priority over or equal to the interest of Lender under this Deed of Truet, except for the lien of taxes and assessments not due and except as otherwise provided in this Deed of Truet.

Right To Contest. Notice of Construction. Lender may make proof of loss if Grantor fails to do so within Steen (15) days of the casualty. Whether or not Lender's security is impeired, Lender may, at its election, receive and retain the proceeds of any insurance and apply the proceeds to the reduction of the Indebtedness, payment of any ten affecting the Property, or the restoration and repair of the Property. TAX AND MESURANCE RESERVES. Subject to any limitations set by applicable law, Lander may require Granfor to maintain with Lander receives for payment of annual taxes, assessments, and insurance premiums, which reserves shall be created by advance payment or monthly payments of a sum estimated by Lander to be sufficient to produce, at least filteen (16) days before due, amounts at least equal to the faxes, assessments, and insurance premiums to be paid. If filteen (16) days before payment is due the reserve funds are insufficient, Granfor shall upon demand pay any deficiency to Lender. The reserve funds shall be held by Lander as a general deposit from Granfor, which Lander may salish by payment of the faxes, assessments, and last the control of the faxes of the and insurance premiums required to be paid by Grantor as they become due. Lender shall have the right to draw upon the reserve funds to pay such lients, and Lender shall not be required to determine the validity or accuracy of any item before paying it. Nothing in the Deed of Trust shall be construed as requiring Lender to advance other monits for such purposes, and Lender shall not incur any liability for any times any do or omit to do with respect to the reserve account. All amounts in the reserve account are hereby pledged to further secure the Indebtudness, and Lender is hereby authorized to all the reserve account. authorized to withdraw and apply such amounts on the indubtedness upon the occurrence of an Event of Delaut. Lender shall not be required to pay any interest or earnings on the reserve funds unless required by law or agreed to by Lander in writing. Lender does not hold the reserve funds in trust for Grantor, and Lender is not Grantor's agent for payment of the taxes and assessments required to be paid by Grantor.

EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. If Grantor tells to comply with any provision of this Deed of Trust, or if any action or proceeding is commenced that would materially affect Lender's interests in the Property, Lender on Grantor's behalf may, but shall not be required to, take any action that Lender deems appropriate. Any amount that Lender expends in so doing will bear interest at the rate charged under the Note from the date incurred or paid by Lender to the date of repayments by Grantor. All such expenses, at Lender's option, will (a) be payable on demand, (b) be added to the belance of the Note and be apportioned among and be psyable with any installment payments to become due during either (i) the term of any applicable insurance policy or (ii) the remaining term of the Note, or (c) be treated as a balloon payment which will be due and psyable at the Note's maturity. This Deed of Trust also will secure payment of these amounts. The rights provided for in this paragraph shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Lender may be entitled on account of the default. Any such action by Lender shall not be construed as curing the default so as to bar Landar from any remedie that it otherwise would have had ber Lender from any remedy that it otherwise would have had.

WARRANTY; DEFENSE OF TITLE. The following provisions relating to ownership of the Property are a part of this Deed of Trust.

Title. Grantor warrants that: (a) Grantor holds good and marketable title of record to the Property in iou simple, true and clear of all tiens and encumbrances other than those set forth in the Real Property description or in any title insurance policy, title report, or final title opinion lesued in tevor of, and accepted by, Lender in connection with this Deed of Truet, and (b) Grantor has the full right, power, and authority to execute and deliver this Deed of Trust to Lender.

were of Title. Subject to the exception in the peragniph above, Grantor warrants and will forever duland the title to the Property against the izwful claims of all persons. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's title or the interest of Trustee or Lender under this Deed of Trust, Grantor shall defend the action at Grantor's expense. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lander shall be entitled to perticipate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by coursel of Lander's own choice, and Grantor will deliver, or cause to be delivered, to Lender such instruments as Lender may request from time to time to permit such participation.

Compliance With Linux. Grantor werrants that the Property and Grantor's use of the Property complies with all existing applicable laws, ordinances, and regulations of governmental authorities, including without limitation at applicable anvironmental laws, ordinances, and regulations, unisses otherwise specifically excepted in the environmental agreement executed by Grantor and Lender relating to the Property.

CONDENNIATION. The following provisions relating to condumnation proceedings are a part of this Deed of Trust.

Application of Net Proceeds. It all or any part of the Property is condemned by entrant domain proceedings or by any proceeding or purchase in feu of condemnation, Londer may at its election require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the award be applied to the indebtedness or the repair or restoration of the Property. The net proceeds of the award shall mean the award after payment of all reasonable costs, expenses, and altorneys' less incurred by Trustee or Lender in connection with the condemnation.

Proceedings. If any proceeding in condemnation is filed, Grantor shall promptly notify Lender in writing, and Grantor shall promptly take such steps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the award. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be ed to perficipate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice all at Grantor's expense, and Grantor will deliver or cause to be delivered to Lender such instruments as may be requested by it from time to time to permit such participation.

IMPOSITION OF TAXES, FEES AND CHARGES BY GOVERNMENTAL AUTHORITIES. The following provisions relating to governmental taxes, fees and charges are a part of this Deed of Trust:

SECURITY AGREEMENT; FINANCING STATEMENTS. The following provisions relating to this Deed of Trust as a security agreement are a part of this Deed of Trust.

Security Agreement. This instrument shall constitute a security agreement to the extent any of the Property constitutes fixtures or other personal property, and Lender shall have all of the rights of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code as amended from time to time.

Security Interest. Upon request by Lander, Grantor shall execute financing statements and take whatever other action is requested by Lander to perfect and continue Lander's security interest in the Rents and Personal Property. In addition to recording this Deed of Trust in the rest property records, Lender may, at any time and without further authorization from Granfor, the executed counterparts, copies or reproductions of this Deed of Trust as a financing statement. Grantor shall relimburate Lander for all expenses incurred in perfecting or continuing this security interest. Upon default, Grantor shall assemble the Personal Property in a manner and at a place reasonably convenient to Grantor and Lender and make it available to Lender within three (3) days after receipt of written demand from Lender.

Addresses. The making addresses of Grantor (debtor) and Lender (secured party), from which information concerning the security interest granted by this Deed of Trust may be obtained (each as required by the Uniform Commorcial Code), are as stated on the first page of this Deed of Trust.

FURTHER ASSURANCES; ATTORNEY-IN-FACT. The following provisions relating to further assurances and attorney-in-fact are a part of this Deed of Trust.

Farther Assurances. At any time, and from time to time, upon request of Lender, Grantor will make, execute and deliver, or will cause to be made, executed or delivered, to Lender or to Lender's designee, and when requested by Lender, cause to be filled, recorded, refilled, or rerecorded, as the case may be, at such times and in such offices and places as Lender may deem appropriate, any and all such mortgages, deeds of trust, security deeds, security agreements, financing statements, confinuation statements, instruments of further assurance, cartificates, and other documents as may, in the sole opinion of Lender, be necessary or desirable in order to effectuate, complete, perfect, continue, or preserve (a) the obligations of Grantor under the Note, this Deed of Trust, and the Fletated Documents, and (b) the liens and security interests created by this Deed of Trust as first and prior liens on the Property, whether now owned or herselfer acquired by Grantor. Unless prohibited by law or agreed to the contrary by Lender in writing, Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all costs and expenses incurred in connection with the matters reterred to in this personant.

Atterney-in-Fect. If Grantor felts to do any of the things reterred to in the preceding paragraph, Lender may do so for and in the name of Grantor and al Crantor's expense. For such purposes, Grantor hereby inevocably appoints Lender as Grantor's attorney-in-fact for the purpose of making, executing, delivering, filing, recording, and doing all other things as may be necessary or desirable, in Lender's sole opinion, to accomplish the matters reterred to in the preceding paragraph.

FULL PERFORMANCE. If Grantor pays at the indebtedness when due, and otherwise performs all the obligations imposed upon Grantor under this Deed of Trust, Lender shall execute and deliver to Trustee a request for full reconveyance and shall execute and deliver to Grantor suitable statements of termination of any financing statement on the evidencing Lender's security interest in the Rente and the Personal Property. Any reconveyance less shall be paid by Grantor, if permitted by applicable law. The grantee in any reconveyance may be described as the "person or persons legally entitled thereto", and the reclass in the reconveyance of any matters or facts shall be conclusive proof of the truthfulness of any such matters or facts.

DEFAULT. Each of the following, at the option of Lender, shall constitute an event of default ("Event of Default") under this Deed of Trust:

Default on Indebtedness. Failure of Granfor to make any payment when due on the Indebtedness.

Detault on Other Payments. Fellure of Grantor within the time required by this Deed of Trust to make any payment for laxes or insurance, or any other payment recessary to prevent fling of or to effect discharge of any tien.

Environmental Delastic. Failure of any party to comply with or perform when due any term, obligation, covenant or condition contained in any environmental agreement executed in connection with the Property.

Compliance Default. Failure to comply with any other term, obligation, coverant or condition contained in this Deed of Trust, the Note or in any of the Related Documents. If such a failure is ourable and if Grantor has not been given a molice of a breach of the same provision of this Deed of Trust within the preceding twelve (12) months, it may be cured (and ne Event of Default will have occurred) if Grantor, after Lender sends written notice demanding cure of such failure: (a) cures the failure within ten (10) days; or (b) if the cure requires more than ion (10) days, immediately inflictes steps sufficient to cure the failure and thereafter continues and compliance as soon as reasonably practical.

False Statements. Any warranty, representation or statement made or furnished to Londor by or on behalf of Grantor under this Deed of Trust, the Note or the Related Documents is false or misseding in any material respect, either now or at the time made or furnished.

Death or Insolvency. The death of any Grantor, the insolvency of Grantor, the appointment of a receiver for any part of Grantor's property, any assignment for the benefit of craditors, any type of craditor workout, or the commencement of any propeeding under any bankruptcy or insolvency laws by or against Grantor.

Foreclosure, Fortellure, etc. Commencement of foreclosure of fortellure proceedings, whether by judicial proceeding, self-help, repossession or any other method, by any creditor of Grantor or by any commental agency against any of the Property. However, this subsection shall not apply in the event of a good faith dispute by Grantor as to the validity or rescondiness of the claim which is the basis of the foreclosure or forefaiture proceeding, provided that Grantor gives Lander written notice of such claim and furnishes reserves or a surely bond for the claim satisfactory to Lander.

Breach of Other Agreement. Any breach by Grantor under the terms of any other agreement between Grantor and Lender that is not remedied within any grace period provided therein, including without limitation any agreement concerning any indebtwiness or other obligation of Grantor to Lender, whether existing now or later.

Events Affecting Guarantor. Any of the proceding events occurs with respect to any Guarantor of any of the Indebtedness or any Guarantor dies or becomes incompetent, or revokes or disputes the validity of, or liability under, any Guaranty of the Indebtedness. Lender, at its option, may, but shall not be required to, permit the Guarantor's callete to assume unconditionally the obligations arising under the guaranty in a manner satisfactory to Lender, and, in doing so, cure the Event of Default.

Insecurity. Leridar in good faith deems liquil insecure.

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RIGHTS AND REMEDIES ON DEFAULT. Upon the occurrence of any Event of Default and at any time thorsefor, Trustee or Lender, at its option, may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law:

Accelerate Indebteduces. Lender shall have the right at its option to declare the entire Indebteduces immediately due and payable, including any prepayment penalty which Grantor would be required to pay.

Foreclistate. With respect to all or any part of the Real Property, the Trustee shall have the right to exercise its power of sale and to foreclose by realise and sale, and Lendor shall have the right to foreclose by judicial foreclosure, in either case in accordance with and to the full education provided by applicable law.

UCC Remedies. With respect to all or any part of the Personal Property, Lender shall have all the rights and remedies of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code.

Collect Rents. Lender shall have the right, without notice to Grantor, to take possession of and manage the Property and collect the Rents, including amounts past due and unpeld, and apply the net proceeds, over and above Lender's costs, against the indebtedness. In furtherance of this right, Lender may require any tenant or other user of the Property to make payments of rent or use fees directly to Lender. If the Pients are collected by Lender, then Grantor irrevocably designates Lender as Grantor's attorney-in-fact to endorse instruments received in payment thereof in the name of Grantor and to negotiate the same and collect the proceeds. Payments by tenants or other users to Lender in response to Lender's demand shall satisfy the obligations for which the payments are made, whether or not any proper grounds for the demand existed. Lender may exercise its rights under this subparagraph either in person, by agent, or through a receiver.

Appoint Receiver. Lender shall have the right to have a receiver appointed to take possession of all or any part of the Property, with the power to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the Property preceding or pending foreclosure or sale, and to collect the Rients from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above the cost of the receivership, against the indebtedness. The receiver may serve without bond if permitted by law. Lender's right to the appointment of a receiver shall exist whether or not the apparent value of the Property exceeds the Indebtedness by a substantial amount. Employment by Lender shall not dequalify a person from serving as a receiver.

Tenancy at Sufference. If Grantor remains in possession of the Property after the Property is sold as provided above or Lender otherwise becomes entitled to possession of the Property upon default of Grantor, Grantor shall become a tenant at sufference of Lender or the purchaser of the Property and shall, at Lender's option, either (a) pay a reasonable rental for the use of the Property, or (b) vecale the Property immediately upon the demand of Lender.

Other Remedies. Trustee or Lender shall have any other right or remedy provided in this Dead of Trust or the Note or by law.

Notice of Sale. Lender shall give Grantor reasonable notice of the time and place of any public sale of the Personal Property or of the time after which any private sale or other intended disposition of the Personal Property is to be made. Reasonable notice shall mean notice given at least ten (10) days before the time of the sale or disposition. Any sale of Personal Property may be made in conjunction with any sale of the Real Property.

Sele of the Property. To the extent permitted by applicable law, Grantor heroby walves any and all rights to have the Property marshalled. In exercising its rights and romedies, the Trustee or Lender shall be free to sell all or any part of the Property logather or separately, in one sale or by separate sales. Lender shall be entitled to bid at any public sale on all or any portion of the Property.

Walver; Election of Remedies. A walver by any party of a breach of a provision of this Deed of Trust shall not constitute a walver of or prejudice the party's rights ofherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. Election by Lender to pursue any remedy provided in this Deed of Trust, the Fiole, in any Related Document, or provided by law shall not exclude pursuit of any other remedy, and an election to make expenditures or to take action to perform an obligation of Grantor under this Deed of Trust after tailure of Grantor to perform shall not effect Lender's right to declare a default and to exercise any of its remedies.

Flights of Trustee. Trustee shall have all of the rights and duties of Lander as set forth in this section.

POWERS AND OBLIGATIONS OF TRUSTEE. The following provisions relating to the powers and obligations of Trustee (pursuent to Lender's instructions) are part of the Deed of Trust.

Powers of Triselee. In addition to all powers of Trustee arising as a matter of few, Trustee shall have the power to take the following actions with respect to the Property upon the written request of Lender and Grantor: (a) join in preparing and filting a map or plat of the Real Property, including the dedication of streets or other rights to the public; (b) join in granting any easement or creating any restriction on the Real Property; and (c) join in any subordination or other agreement affecting this Deed of Trust or the Interest of Lender under this Deed of Trust.

Obligations to Notify. Trustee shall not be obligated to notify any other party of a pending sale under any other trust deed or lien, or of any action or proceeding in which Grantor, Lender, or Trustee shall be a party, unless required by applicable law, or unless the action or proceeding is brought by Trustee.

Trustee. Trustee shall meet all qualifications recuired for Trustee under applicable law. In addition to the rights and remedies set forth above, with respect to all or any part of the Property, the Trustee shall have the right to forecide by notice and sale, and Lender shall have the right to foreclose by judicial foreclosure, in either case in accordance with and to the full extent provided by applicable law.

Successor Trustee, Lender, at Lender's option, may from time to time appoint a successor Trustee to any Trustee appointed hereunder by an instrument executed and acknowledged by Lender and recorded in the office of the recorder of SKAMANIA County, Washington. The instrument shall confain, in addition to all other matters required by state law, the names of the original Lender, Trustee, and Grantor, the book and page or the Auditor's File Number where this Deed of Trust is recorded, and the name and address of the successor trustee, and the instrument shall be executed and acknowledged by Lender or its successors in Interest. The successor trustee, without conveyance of the Property, shall success to all the title, power, and dulies conferred upon the Trustee in this Deed of Trust and by applicable law. This procedure for substitution of trustee shall govern to the exclusion of all other provisions for substitution.

NOTICES TO GRANTOR AND OTHER PARTIES. Subject to applicable law, and except for notice required or allowed by law to be given in another manner, any notice under this Deed of Trust shall be in writing, may be be sent by telefacsimile, and shall be effective when actually delivered, or when deposited with a nationally recognized overnight courier, or, if mailed, shall be deemed effective when deposited in the United States mail first class, certified or registered mail, postage prepaid, directed to the addresses shown near the beginning of this Deed of Yrust. Any party may change its address for notices under this Deed of Trust by giving formst written notice to the other perses, specifying that the purpose of the notice is to change the party's address. All copies of notices of foreclosure from the holder of any lien which has priority over this Deed of Truet shall be sent to Lender's address, as shown near the beginning of this Deed of Trust. For notice purposes, Grantor agrees to keep Lunder and Trustee informed at all times of Grantor's current address.

ATTORNEY'S PEES. If Lender must take any action to enforce any part of this agreement, I agree to pay all costs and expenses of collection, suit or action, including reasonable attorney's fees and the value of services of staff counsel, which are incurred prior to or during trial or on appeal. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS. The following miscellaneous provisions are a part of this Deed of Trust

Amendments. This Deed of Truet, together with any Related Documents, constitutes the entire understanding and agreement of the parties as to the matters set forth in this Deed of Truet. No alteration of or amendment to this Deed of Truet shall be effective unless given in writing and signed by the party or parties sought to be charged or bound by the alteration or amendment.

splicable Law. This Deed of Trust has been delivered to Lander and accepted by Lender in the State of Washington. This Deed of Trust all be governed by and construed in accordance with the taws of the State of Washington.

Caption Headings. Caption headings in this Deed of Trust are for convenience purposes only and are not to be used to interpret or define the provisions of this Deed of Trust.

flerger. There shall be no merger of the interest or estate created by this Deed of Trust with any other interest or estate in the Property at any time held by or for the benefit of Lecder in any capacity, without the written consent of Lender.

Severability. If a court of competent jurisdiction finds any provision of this Deed of Trust to be invested or unenforceable as to any person or circumstance, such finding shall not render that provision invalid or unerforceable as to any other persons or circumstances. If feesible, any such disending provision shall be deemed to be modified to be within the limits of enforceability or validity; however, if the offending provision cannot be id, it shall be stricken and all other provisions of this Deed of Trust in all other respects shall remain valid and enforceable.

Successors and Assigns. Subject to the limitations stated in this Deed of Trust on transfer of Granton's Interest, this Deed of Trust shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties, their successors and seeigns. No delay or omission on the part of Lender in exercising any right shall operate as a waiver of such right or any other right. A waiver by any party of a provision of this Deed of Trust shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's right otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. No prior waiver by Lender, nor any course of dealing between Lender and Grantor, shall constitute a weiver of any of Lender's rights or any of Grantor's obligations as to any future transactions. Whenever consent by Lender is required in this Deed of Trust, the granting of such consent by Lender in any instance shall not constitute continuing consent to subsequent instances where such consent is required.

Welver of Homesteed Exemption. Grantor hereby releases and waives all rights and benefits of the homesteed exemption laws of the State of Washington as to all indebtedness secured by this Deed of Trust.
