Assignment of Rents and Security Agreement

THIS DEED OF TRUST IS DATED APRIL 8, 1994, among MICHAEL D. LESH, MICHAEL D. LESH, A SINGLE MAN, whose mailing address is P.O. BOX 711, CASCADE LOCKS, OR 97014 (referred to below as "Grantor"); First Interstate Bank of Oregon, N.A., whose mailing address is 304 OAK STREET, 304 OAK STREET BOX 330, HOOD RIVER, OR 97031 (referred to below sometimes as "Lender" and sometimes as "Beneficiary"); and SKAMANIA TITLE CO, whose mailing address is SKAMANIA WA (referred to below as "Trustee").

CONVEYANCE AND GRANT. For valuable consideration, Grantor conveys to Trustee in trust with power of sale, right of every and possession and for the benefit of Lender as Beneficiary, all of Grantor's right, title, and Interest in and to any Lease the following described real property, together with all existing or subsequently erected or affixed buildings, improvements and fixtures; all assuments, rights of way, and appurenances; all water, water rights and ditch rights (including stock in utilities with ditch or irrigation rights); and all other rights, royalties, and profits relating to the real property, including without limitation all minerals, oil, gas, geothermal and similar matters, located in SKAMANIA County, State of Washington (the "Real Property");

### SEE ATTACHED EXHIBIT "A" HERETO ATTACHED AND BY THIS REFERENCE INCORPORATED HEREIN

The Real Property or its address is condmortly known as MP.125 BEAR CREEK RD N, CARSON, WA 98610. The Real Property tax identification number is 03 06 05 0 0 0509 00.

Grantor hereby assigns as security to Lender, all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to all leases, Rents, and profits of the Property. This assignment is recorded in accordance with RCW 85.08.070; the lien created by this assignment is intended to be specific, perfected and chosts upon the recording of this Deed of Trust. Lender grants to Grantor a license to collect the Rents and profits, which license may be revoked at Lender's option and shall be automatically revoked upon acceleration of all or part of the Indebtedness.

**DEFINITIONS.** The following words shall have the following mannings when used in this Deed of Trust. Terms not otherwise defined in this Deed of Trust shall have the meanings attributed to such terms in the Oregon Uniform Commercial Code.

Credit Agreement. The words "Credit Agreement" mean the revolving credit agreement duted April 8, 1994, with a credit limit in the amount of \$15,000.00, between Grantor and Lender, together with all renewals, extensions, modifications, refinancings, and substitutions for the Credit Agreement. The maturity date of this Deed of Trust is April 13, 4694. NOTICE TO GRANTOR: THE CREDIT AGREEMENT CONTAINS A VARIABLE INTEREST RATE.

Existing Indebtedness. The words "Existing Indebtedness" mean the Indebtedness described below in the Existing Indebtedness section of this Deed of Trust.

improvements. The word "improvements" means and includes without limitation all existing and future improvements, focures, buildings, structures, mobile homes affixed on the Real Property, facilities, additions and other construction on the Real Property.

Indebtedness. The word "indebtedness" means all principal and interest payable under the Credit Agreement and any amounts expended or advanced by Lender to discharge obligations of Grantor or expenses incurred by Truste or Lender to enforce obligations of Grantor under this Deed of Trust, together with interest on such amounts as provided in this Deed of Trust. Specifically, without limitation, this Deed of Trust secures a revolving line of credit, with a variable rate of interest, which obligates Lender to make advances to Grantor up to the credit limit so long as Grantor compiles with all the terms of the Credit Agreement and the line of credit has not been terminated, suspended or cancelled; the Credit Agreement allows negative amortization. Such advances may be made, repeld, and remade from time to time, subject to the limitation that the total outstanding balance owing at any one time, not including finance charges on such belance at fixed or variable rate or sum as provided in the Credit Agreement, any temporary overages, other charges, and any amounts expended or advanced as provided in this paragraph, shall not exceed the Credit Limit as provided in the Credit Agreement. It is the intention of Grantor and Lender that this Deed of Trust secures the balance outstanding under the Credit Agreement from time to time from zero up to the Credit Limit as provided above and any intermediate balance. Funds may be advanced by Lender, repaid, and subsequently readvanced. Notwithstanding the amount outstanding at any particular time, this Deed of Trust secures the total Credit Agreement amount shown above. The unpaid balance of the revolving line of credit may at certain times be lower than the amount shown or zero. A zero balance does not terminate the line of credit or terminate Lender's obligation to advance funds to Grantor. Therefore, the lien of this Deed of Trust will remain in full force and effect notwithstanding any zero balance.

Personal Property. The words "Personal Property" mean all equipment, fixtures, and other articles of personal property now or hereafter owned by Grantor, and now or hereafter attached or affixed to the Roal Property; together with all accessions, parts, and additions to, all replacements of, and all substitutions for, any of such property; and together with all issues and profits thereon and proceeds (including without limitation all insurance proceeds and refunds of premiums) from any sale or other disposition of the Property.

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### DEED OF TRUST (Continued)

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Property. The word "Property" means collectively the Real Property and the Personal Property.

Real Property. The words "Real Property" mean the property, interests and rights described above in the "Conveyance and Grant" section.

Related Documents. The words "Related Documents" mean and Include without limitation all promissory notes, credit agreements, loan agreements, guaranties, security agreements, mortgages, deeds of trust, and all other instruments and documents, whether now or hereafter existing, executed in connection with Grantor's Indebtedness to Lender.

Rents. The word "Rents" means all present and future rents, revenues, income, issues, royalties, profits, and other benefits derived from the Property.

THIS DEED OF TRUST, INCLUDING THE ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS AND THE SECURITY INTEREST IN THE RENTS AND PERSONAL PROPERTY, IS GIVEN TO SECURE (1) PAYMENT OF THE INDEBTEDNESS AND (2) PERFORMANCE OF EACH AGREEMENT AND OBLIGATION OF GRANTOR UNDER THE CREDIT AGREEMENT, THE RELATED DOCUMENTS, AND THIS DEED OF TRUST. THIS DEED OF TRUST IS GIVEN AND ACCEPTED ON THE FOLLOWING TERMS:

PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE. Except as otherwise provided in this Deed of Trust, Grantor shall pay to Lender all amounts secured by this Deed of Trust as they become due, and shall strictly and in a timely manner perform all of Grantor's obligations under the Credit Agreement and this Deed of Trust.

POSSESSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PROPERTY. Grantor agrees that Grantor's possession and use of the Property shall be governed by the following provisions:

Possession and Use. Until the occurrence of an Event of Default, Grantor may (a) remain in possession and control of the Property, (b) use, operate or manage the Property, and (c) collect any Rents from the Property (this privilege is a license from Lender to Grantor automatically revoked upon default). The following provisions relate to the use of the Property or to other limitations on the Property. The Real Property is not used principally for agriculture or farming purposes.

Duty to Maintain. Grantor shall maintain the Property in tenantable condition and promptly perform all repairs, replacements, and maintenance necessary to preserve its value.

Hazardous Substances. Grantor represents and warrants that the Property never has been, and never will be so long as this Deed of Trust remains a lien on the Property, used for the generation, manufacture, storage, treatment, disposal, release or threatened release of any hazardous waste or substance, as those terms are defined in the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act of 1980, as amended, 42 U.S.C. Section 9601, et seq. ("CERCLA"), the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act ("SARA"), applicable state or Federal lews, or regulations adopted pursuant to any of the foregoing. Grantor authorizes Lender and its agents to enter upon the Property to make such inspections and tests as Lender may deem appropriate to determine compliance of the Property with this section of the Deed of Trust. Grantor hereby (a) releases and waives any future claims against Lender for Indemnity or contribution in the event Grantor becomes lable for cleanup or other costs under any such laws, and (b) agrees to indemnity and hold harmless Lender against any and all claims and losses resulting from a breach of this paragraph of the Deed of Trust. This obligation to indemnity shall survive the payment of the Indebtedness and the satisfaction of this Deed of Trust.

Nulsance, Waste. Grantor shall not cause, conduct or permit any nulsance nor commit, permit, or suffer any stripping of or waste on or to the Property or any portion of the Property. Specifically without limitation, Grantor will not remove, or grant to any other perty the right to remove, any timber, minerals (including oil and gas), soil, gravel or rock products without the prior written consent of Lender.

DUE COLSALE - CONSENT BY LENDER. Lender may, at its option, (a) declare immediately due and payable all sums secured by this Deed of Trust or (b) increase the interest rate provided for in the Credit Agreement or other document evidencing the indebtedness and impose such other conditions as Lender deems appropriate, upon the sale or transfer, without the Lender's prior written consent, of all or any part of the Real Property, or any interest in the Real Property. A "sale or transfer" means the conveyance of real property or any right, title or interest therein; whether legal or equitable; whether voluntary or involuntary; whether by outright sale, deed, installment sale contract, land contract contract for deed, leasehold interest with a term greater than three (3) years, lease-option contract, or by sale, assignment, or transfer of any beneficial interest in or to any land trust holding title to the Real Property, or by any other method of conveyance of real property interest. If any Grantor is a corporation or partnership, transfer also includes any change in ownership of more than twenty-five percent (25%) of the voting stock or partnership interests, as the case may be, of Grantor. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender II such exercise is prohibited by federal law or by Washington law.

TAXES AND LIENS. The following provisions relating to the tense and liens on the Property are a part of this Deed of Trust.

Payment. Grantor shall pay when due (and in all events prior to delinquency) all taxes, special taxes, assessments, charges (including water and sewer), fines and impositions levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for work done on or for services rendered or material furnished to the Property. Grantor shall maintain the Property free of all liens having priority over or equal to the interest of Lender under this Deed of Trust, except for the iden of taxes and assessments not due, except for the existing indebtedness referred to below, and except as otherwise provided in this Deed of Trust.

PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE. The following provisions relating to insuring the Property are a part of this Deed of Trust.

Minimisence of insurance. Grantor shall procure and maintain policies of the insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable value covering all improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a standard mortgages clause in favor of Lender, together with such other hazard and liability insurance as Lender may reasonably require. Policies shall be written in form, amounts, coverages and basis reasonably acceptable to Lender and issued by a company or companies reasonably acceptable to Lender. Grantor, upon request of Lender, will deliver to Lender from time to time the policies or certificates of insurance in form satisfactory to Lender, including stipulations that coverages will not be cancelled or diminished without at least ten (10) days' prior written notice to Lender.

EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. If Grantor fails to comply with any provision of this Deed of Trust, including any obligation to maintain Existing Indebtedness in good standing as required below, or if any action or proceeding is commenced that would materially affect Lender's interests in the Property, Lender on Grantor's behalf may, but shall not be required to, take any action that Lender deems appropriate. Any amount that Lender expends in so doing will beer interest at the rate charged under the Credit Agreement from the date incurred or paid by Lender to the date of repayment by Grantor. All such expenses, at Lender's option, will (a) be payable on demand, (b) be added to the balance of the credit line and be apportioned among and be payable with any installment payments to become due during either (i) the term of any applicable insurance policy or (ii) the remaining term of the Credit Agreement's maturity. This Deed of Trust also will secure payment of these amounts. The rights provided for in this paragraph shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Lander may be entitled on account of the default. Any such action by Lender shall not be construed as curing the default so as to ber Lender from any remedy that it otherwise would have had.

WARRANTY; DEFENSE OF TITLE. The following provisions relating to ownership of the Property are a part of this Deed of Trust.

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Title. Granter warrants that: (a) Granter holds good and marketable title of record to the Property in fee simple, free and clear of all liens and encumbrances either than those set forth in the Real Property description or in the Existing Indebledness section below or in any title insurance policy, the report, or final title opinion issued in favor of, and accepted by, Lender in connection with this Deed of Trust, and (b) Granter has the full right, power, and authority to execute and deliver this Deed of Trust to Lender.

Defense of Title. Subject to the exception in the paragraph above, Grantor warrants and will forever defend the title to the Property against the lewful claims of all persons.

EXISTING INDESTEDNESS. The following provisions concerning existing indebtedness (the "Existing Indebtedness") are a part of this Deed of Trust.

Existing Lien. The lien of this Deed of Trust securing the Indebtedness may be secondary and inferior to the lien securing payment of an existing obligation. The existing obligation has a current principal balance of approximately \$38,000.00. Grantor expressly covenants and agrees to pay, or see to the payment of, the Existing Indebtedness and to prevent any default on such Indebtedness, any default under the instruments evidencing such Indebtedness, or any default under any security documents for such Indebtedness.

DEFAULT. Each of the following, at the option of Lender, shall constitute an event of default ("Event of Default") under the Deed of Trust: (a) Grantor committe fraud or makes a material misrepresentation at any time in connection with the credit line account. This can include, for example, a false statement about Grantor's income, assets, liabilities, or any other aspects of Grantor's financial condition. (b) Grantor does not meet the repayment terms of the credit line account. (c) Grantor's action or inaction adversely affects the collateral for the credit line account or Lender's rights in the collateral. This can include, for example, failure to maintain required insurance, waste or destructive use of the dwelling, failure to pay taxes, death of all persons liable on the account, transfer of title or sale of the dwelling, creation of a lien on the dwelling without our permission, foreclosure by the holder of another lien, or the use of funds or the dwelling for prohibited purposes.

RIGHTS AND REMEDIES ON DEFAULT. Upon the occurrence of any Event of Default and at any time thereafter, Trustee or Lender, at its option, may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law:

Accelerate Indebtedness. Lender shall have the right at its option to declare the entire Indebtedness immediately due and payable, including any prepayment penalty which Grantor would be required to pay.

Foreclosure. With respect to all or any part of the Real Property, the Trustee shall have the right to exercise its power of sale and to foreclose by notice and eals, and Lender shall have the right to foreclose by judicial foreclosure, in either case in accordance with and to the full extent provided by applicable law.

Other Remedies. Trustee or Lender shall have any other right or remedy provided in this Deed of Trust or the Credit Agreement or by law.

Sale of the Property. To the extent permitted by applicable law, Grantor hereby waives any and all rights to have the Property marshalled. In exercising its rights and remedies, the Trustee or Lender shall be free to sell all or any part of the Property together or separately, in one sale or by separate sales. Lender shall be entitled to bid at any public sale on all or any portion of the Property.

Atterneys' Fees; Expenses. If Lender institutes any suit or action to enforce any of the terms of this Deed of Trust, Lender shall be entitled to recover such sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys' fees at trial and on any appeal. Whether or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expenses incurred by Lender which in Lender's option are necessary at any time for the protection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the Indebtedness payable on demand and shall bear interest at the Credit Agreement rate from the date of expenditure until repaid. Expenses covered by this paragraph include, without limitation, however subject to any limits under applicable law, Lender's attorneys' fees whether or not there is a lewisuit, including attorneys' fees for bankruptcy proceedings (including efforts to modify or vacate any automatic stay or injunction), appeals and any anticipated post-judgment collection services, the cost of searching records, obtaining life reports (including foreclosure reports), surveyors' reports, appraisal fees, title insurance, and fees for the Trustee, to the extent permitted by applicable law. Grantor also will pay any court costs, in addition to all other sums provided by law.

MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS. The following miscellaneous provisions are a part of this Deed of Trust:

Applicable Law. This Deed of Trust has been delivered to Lender and accepted by Lender in the State of Oregon. Except as set forth hereinefter, this Deed of Trust shall be governed by, construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Oregon, except and only to the extent of procedural matters related to the perfection and enforcement by Lender of its rights and numedies against the Property, which matters shall be governed by the laws of the State of Washington. However, in the event that the enforceshility or validity of any provision of this Deed of Trust is challenged or questioned, such provision shall be governed by whichever applicable state or federal law would uphold or would enforce such challenged or questioned provision. The tour transaction which is evidenced by the Credit Agreement and this Deed of Trust (which secures the Credit Agreement) has been applied for, considered, approved and made in the State of Oregon.

Time is of the Essence. Time is of the essence in the performance of this Deed of Trust.

Walvers and Consents. Lender shall not be deemed to have walved any rights under this Deed of Trust (or under the Related Documents) unless such welver is in writing and signed by Lender. No delay or omission on the part of Lender in exercising any right shall operate as a walver of such right or any other right. A walver by any party of a provision of this Deed of Trust shall not constitute a walver of or prejudice the party's right otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. No prior walver by Lender, nor any course of dealing between Lender and Grantor, shall constitute a walver of any of Lender's rights or any of Grantor's obligations as to any future transactions. Whenever consent by Lender is required in this Deed of Trust, the granting of such consent by Lender in any instance shall not constitute continuing consent to subsequent instances where such consent is required.

Walver of Hemostead Exemption. Grantor hereby releases and waives all rights and benefits of the homestead exemption laws of the State of Washington as to all Indebtudness secured by this Deed of Trust.

EACH GRANTON ACKNOWLEDGES HAVING READ ALL THE PROVISIONS OF THIS DEED OF TRUST, AND EACH GRANTON AGREES TO ITS TERMS.
