5. EQUALS: The amount the garnishee holds for the second answer \$ 425.34
6. PLUS: The amount garnishee held under first answer \$ 510.00
7. EQUALS: THE TOTAL AMOUNT HELD BY GARNISHEE UNDER THE FIRST & SECOND ANSWERS (No. 5 + No. 6) + 255.00 \$ 1,190.34

The amount you enter in item #4 is the exempt amount and must be paid to the defendant at the regular pay time. List all of the personal property or effects of defendant in the garnishee's possession or control when the writ was served.
