**NOTICE OF MERGER OF NATIONAL BANK FOR COOPERATIVES AND
SPRINGFIELD BANK FOR COOPERATIVES AND FARM CREDIT BANK OF
SPRINGFIELD INTO CoBANK, ACB**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT:

NATIONAL BANK FOR COOPERATIVES has merged with the Springfield Bank for Cooperatives and the Farm Credit Bank of Springfield to form CoBANK, ACB, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the United States of America, effective January 1, 1995.

The National Bank for Cooperatives, the Springfield Bank for Cooperatives and the Farm Credit Bank of Springfield were each a federally chartered corporation of the United States existing under the provisions of the Farm Credit Act of 1971, as amended.

In accordance with the authority of the Agricultural Credit Act of 1987, on January 1, 1995, the National Bank for Cooperatives merged with the Springfield Bank for Cooperatives and the Farm Credit Bank of Springfield to form CoBank, ACB.

The business formally conducted by the National Bank for Cooperatives has been succeeded to and is now being conducted by CoBank, ACB with all of the power and authority of the above-named banks prior to said merger. CoBank, ACB is liable for any and all obligations incurred by the National Bank for Cooperatives, and is successor to any and all contractual rights of the National Bank for Cooperatives.

CoBank, ACB is empowered to reconvey, release, discharge or assign deeds of trust, mortgages, and other security instruments of whatever nature made in favor of the National Bank for Cooperatives or wherein the National Bank for Cooperatives is named trustee, mortgagee, secured party, or beneficiary or has become such by virtue of assignment of said security instrument or by virtue of endorsement of the note secured by said security instruments.

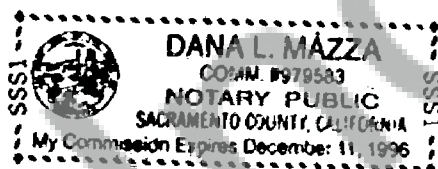


