A portion of the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 34, T. 2 N., R. 5 E.W.M., Skamania County, Washington described as follows:

BEGINNING at a 5/8" iron rod at the Northwest corner of the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter as set in book 1 of Surveys at page 244 Skamania County Auditor's Records; thence South 01° 12' 11" West along the West line of the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter 210.00 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence South 89° 10' 21" East, 417.33 feet; thence South 47° 52' 13" East, 200.00 feet; thence South 42° 07' 47" West, 100.00 feet; thence South 47° 51' 13" East, 300.00 feet to a ½ inch iron rod on the Northwesterly right-of-way line of a 60 foot private road and utility easement as shown in Book 1 of surveys at page 149; thence following said right-of-way line South 55° 00' 08" West, 193.46 feet; thence along the arc of a 150 foot radius curve to the left for an arc distance of 127.75 feet; thence South 08° 10' 00" West, 12.29 feet; thence along the arc of a 470.00 foot radius curve to the right for an arc distance of 123.05 feet; thence South 21° 10' 00" West, 34.16 feet to the South line of "Tract 6" as shown in Book 1 of Surveys at pages 148 and page 244; thence leaving said Northwesterly right-of-way line North 89° 07' 03" West, 471.39 feet to the West line of the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter; thence North 61° 12' 11" East, 811.55 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

PROVISIONS

"A low flow of 175 cubic feet per second (cfs), as measured in the Washougal River, at the United States Geological Survey gaging station #114143500, located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, T. 2 N., R. 4 E.W.M., is recommended by the Departments of Fisheries and Wildlife. Accordingly, water allocated under this permit is limited to in-house domestic supply only, during that time when flows fall below 175 cfs in the Washougal River."

At such time that the Department of Ecology determines the regulation and management of the subject waters is necessary and in the public interest, an approved measuring device shall be installed and maintained in accordance with RCW 90.05.360 and WAC 508-64-029 through -040.

The rights to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein except as provided in RCW 90.03.390, 90.03.390, and 90.44.020.

This certificate of water right is subsequently subject to reclassification for purposes of water use provided in Rule 2014.150.
