WATER OPERATIONS

Wauna Lake Club, hereinafter referred to as the Club, is a nonprofit organization incorporated under the laws of the State of Washington for family recreational purposes. The Club is the fee simple owner of approximately 677.75 acres of land in Skamania County, Washington, and also a purveyor of water for domestic purposes to certain summer homes belonging to its members. The members lease their homesites from the Club. Upon the acreage is a well site and a sanitation control area having a radius of 100 feet surrounding the well site. The site is located on Club property in said county and state at the following point:

1710 feet South and 225 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 15 of Township 2 North, Range 7 East of the Willamette Meridian, as shown on the attached sketch, marked Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein, prepared by Lee Engineering, Inc., Consulting Engineers, Oregon City, Oregon.

By this Declaration, the Club hereby imposes the following covenants restricting the use of the site and land within a circle having a radius of 100 feet from the site:

1. No source of contamination may be constructed, stored, disposed of, or applied without the permission of the Washington Department of Health and the Club; and

2. If any change in ownership of the system or sanitary control area is considered, all affected parties shall be informed of these requirements.

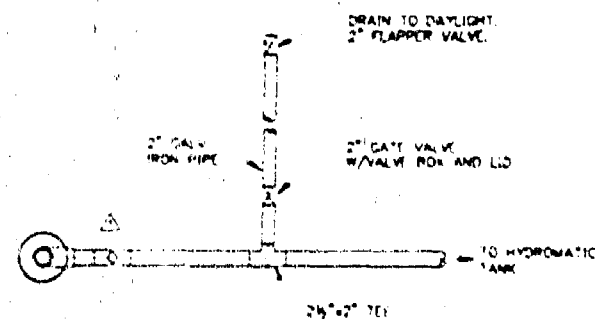

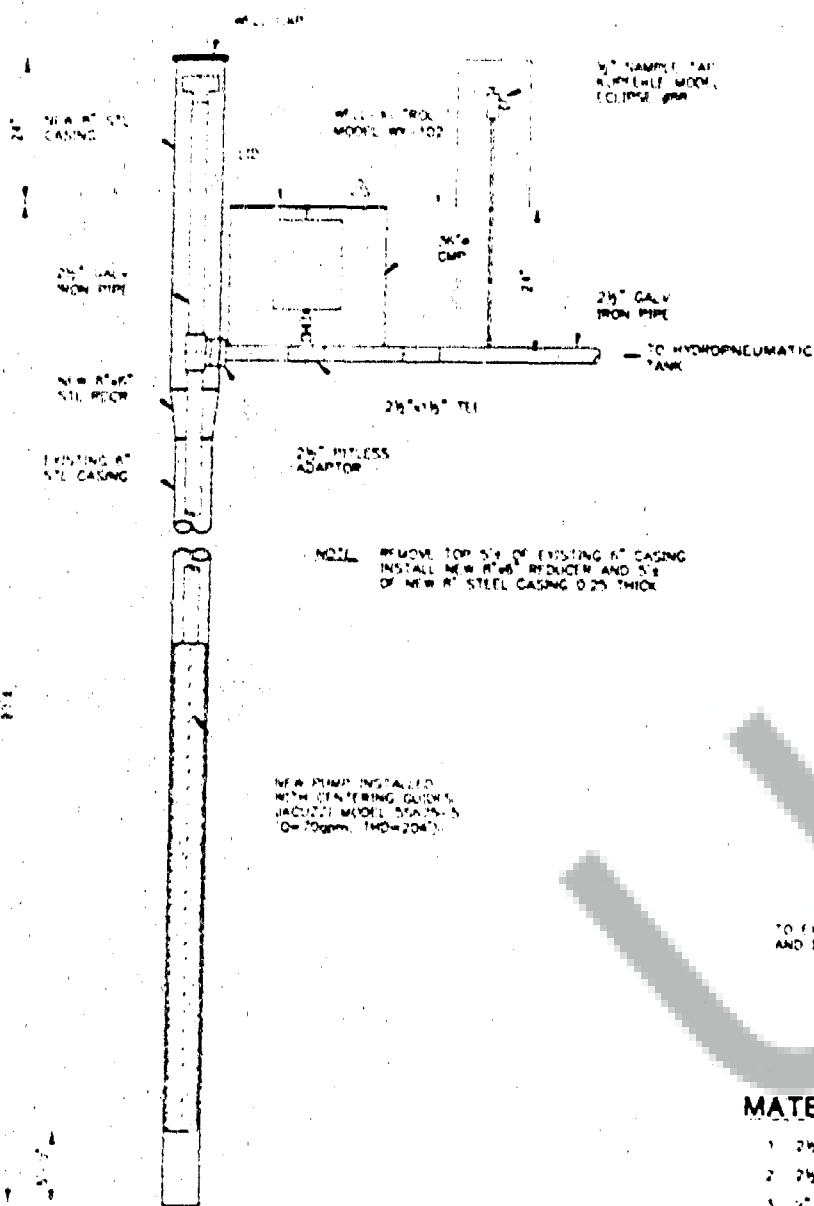

WELL DETAIL

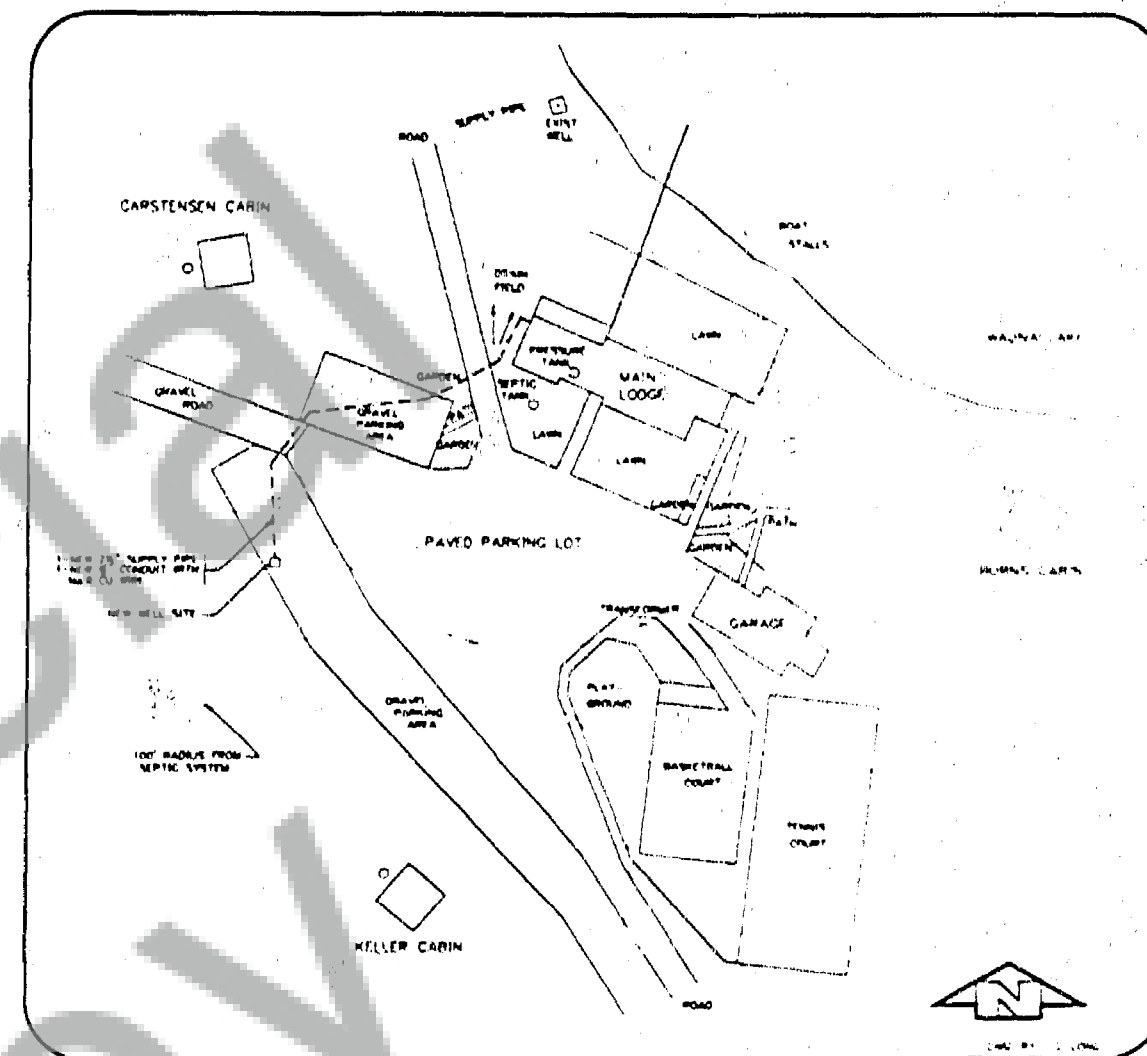
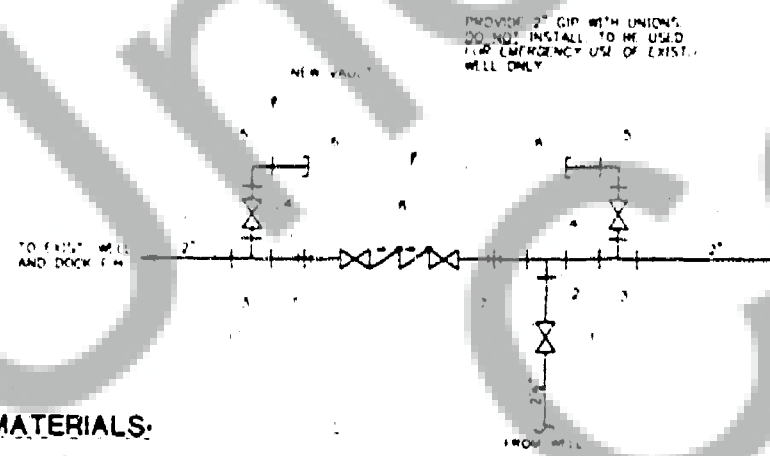

- 2) INSTALL NEW 1 1/2 inch WATER METER IN MAIN LODGE DOWNSTREAM OF EXISTING PRESSURE TANK.
