Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement of May 24, 1984, which has now become effective, Water Front Recreation previously offered to the lessee of the above referenced cabin site an opportunity to extend the lesse from the original termination date of June 1, 2025 to an extended date of June 1, 2069.—The extended date reflects the extension of Water Front Recreation's Master Restated Lesse with the State of Washington.

Our records indicate that the lessee at the time of offering did not opt to extend the lease. Water Front Recreation has now received a written request from the current lessee requesting that such extension of the lease now be offered.

Water Front Recreation has agreed to grant such extension at no charge provided that the request be in writing and received in the office of Water Front Recreation prior to July 1, 1991. Lessee's acceptance of the offer to extend the lease is confirmed by signing and dating this offer and returning it to Water Front Recreation within 30 days of the date of the offer.

The extension of the lease is on the same terms and conditions as existing under that Cabin Site Lease, as amended by the Settlement Agreement of May 24, 1984 (and as superseded by any subsequent Cabin Site Lease executed by or assumed by you). Cabin site rents for the period June 1, 2025 to June 1, 2069 shall be determined based on the provisions set forth in paragraph 10.3 of the Settlement Agreement.

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CABIN SITE LEASE

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SECTION 1. OCCUPANCY

1.01 Term. This Lease is granted for the period beginning ... terminating on June 1, 2025, unless sponer terminated as hereinafter provided.

1.02 Master Lease. Lessor holds the above described premises under a lease, hereinafter referred to as the "master lease," dated August 11, 1970, from the State of Washington, acting by and through the Department of

1.03 Master Lease Incorporated. The master lease is on file with Lessor and is available for inspection. Lessee's rights hereunder are subject to all the terms, provisions, exceptions and reservations set forth in said master lease (as to which Lessee is a sub-lessee) and incorporated herein by reference, including, without limiting the foregoing an easement for right of way for an accets road acquired by the United States of America, United States Forest Service and the right of the State of Washington to inspect the premises at reasonable times.

SECTION 2. RENTAL

Dollars (\$ 400.00). Rent shall be paid in advance, on the first day of September in each year, hereinsteer referred to as the "anniversary date." All payments shall be made to Lessor at 9655 S.W. Canyon Road, Portland, Oregon, or at such other place at which the Lessor may notify the Lessee in writing. Rent for the fraction of an Jessee year shall be prorated. The lease year shall be from September 1 through the succeeding August.

2.02 Rent Adjustments. Lessor may, as of any anniversary date, increase the annual rental as follows:

(a) Under the master lease, Lessor's rental to the State of Washington may be increased on June 1, 1980, and at intervals of not less than ten (10) years thereofter. Lessor may increase Lessee's rental herounder at such times as Lessor's rental under the master lesse is increased. The amount of such increase that the Lessoe shall be responsible for and required to pay shall equal the total annual increase under the master lesse to Lessor multiplied by the Lessoe's annual rental to the Lessor divided by the total annual rental of the Lessees of the sites in the North Woods. Annual rental as used herein shall mean the total rent the Lessee is required to pay to Lessor for the year immediately preceding the year of the increase. The aforesaid formula is illustrated as follows:

(b) In addition to the increase permitted under subparagraph (a) above, Lessor may as of any aninversery date, increase the annual rental hereunder on account of taxes and assessments against said real property in an amount, which together with prior increases on account of taxes and assessments, shell not exceed the total of the amount by which taxes and assessments on the land covered by the master lease exceeds such taxes for 1970, divided by the number of improved cabin sites on said anniversary date.

(c) Finalty, every ten years beginning September 1, 1985, the annual rental shall, at the option of the Lessor, be adjusted to reflect the percent of increase from September 1,1975, in the Consumer Price Index as published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, U.S. Department of Labor; that is, the annual rental each year for the succeeding ten years shall be increased as compared with the annual rental as set forth herein by the same percentage as the increase in said ... Consumer Price Index differs from said Index for September 1, 1975.

SECTION 3, LESSOR'S CONVENANTS

3.01 Declaration. In order to preserve the natural beauty of the North Woods, to provide for the control of structures erected thereon, improvements to be made thereon, and for the purpose of extending to the residents therein the greatest possible peace, enjoyment, privacy, health, comfort, safety, and preservation of property values, Lessor does hereby certify and declare that with the sole exception of lot 19, which is the North Woods Sales Office, the following reservations, conditions, covenents, agreements and restrictions shall become and are hereby made a part of all leases of property within the plat of the North Woods as the same appears on the map survey recorded in the office of the County Auditor of Skartania County, Washington.

3.02 Boat Dock. Lessor shall construct a boat dock for the common use of residents of the North Woods. In the event construction of said boat dock is not completed by September 1, 1972, it is hereby agreed that in lieu of such construction, Lessor shall contribute \$5,000.00 to the North Woods Association, hereinafter described in paragraph 5.09, for construction of such dock.

SECTION 4 LISE OF SITE

Proceedings and the grant grades.

4.01 Permitted Use. The cabin site shall be used only for residential purposer. No building shall be erected, altered, placed, or permitted to remain on the cabin site other than one detached single family dwelling and buildings incidental to residential use, and the cabin site shall not be further subdivided into building kits.

4.02 Condition of Site. The premises hereby leased have been inspected by Lesse and are accepted in their present condition.

4.03 Vehicles. No vehicles shall be parked in roadways. Vehicles shall not be operated carelesely or access of posted speeds. No vehicle shall be operated at any time without a mulfiler in good working order. Excessive motor noise or annoying smoke are forbidden.

4.04 Maintenance. All lots shall at all times be kept in a clean, sightly, and wholesome condition and no tresh, garbage, litter, junk, boxes, containers, bottles, cans, machinery, implements, lumber, or other building materials shall be permitted to be or remain exposed on any lot and visible from any street or adjoining or nearby premise.

4.05 Signs. No signs of any kind shall be displayed to the public view on any lot in the tract except one professional sign, of not more than 18 inches by 24 inches in size, advertising the property for sale or rent, and except signs used by a builder or developer to advertise the property during the construction and sales period.

4.06 Nuisence. No noxious or offensive trade or activity shell be carried on or upon any lot in the tract nor shell anything be done thereon which may be of become an annoyance or nuisence in the area.

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SECTION 5. IMPROVEMENTS continued

4.37 Anim ida. No an te animals, livestock, or poultry of any kind shall be raised, bred, or hept on any let secheld pets may be kept, but not for any commercial purpose. Heweleski pets sha daile on action par e an annoyance or nuisance to the neighborhood.

4.98 Incineration. Because of unpleasant odors and unsightliness, no individu permitted on any loc

4.99 Fires and Fireplaces. Interior fireplaces, stoves, or other type burner must be fire-sens. All fires must be extinguished before leaving cabin. No fires shall be list or multiplina.

es and Fireworks. Discharging fireerms, firecrackers, rockets or any other fire area shall be prohibited.

4.11 Commercial Use. No platted lot shall be used for any commercial purpose, except a size from time to time, and in such case shall be responsible that his tenants abide by these earlies.

4.12 Motorbikes. No motorbike or motorcycle riding of any nature shall be allo

4.13 Fire Extinguisher. One fire extinguisher (minimum two quert capacity) must be kept in every cable

4.14 Trailers and Tents. No tent, house trailer, or mobile home, whether the same be on wheels or not; shell be permitted on any lot except during the period of cabin construction and for guests over a workend period.

4.15 Solicitation. There shall be no solicitation or distribution of handbills or circulation of says kind without the written consent of Lessor.

4.18 Hose Bibs. One hose bib shall be installed on outside well of each cabin for fire prote completion of the cabin.

SECTION 5. IMPROVEMENTS

5.01 Plans Approved. No building shall be rected, placed, or altered on the cabin site until t struction plans showing the location of the structure have been approved by the Lessor as to conformity with plan of development, quality of workmanship and materials, harmony of external design and color with existing structures and to location with respect to topography and finish grade elevation. Such approval shall be in writing.

5.02 Building Materials. All building construction shall be of log or wood frame. Wood frame as simulated brick veneer construction is expressly prohibited. All roofs shall be of wood shingle or shake, or of an accomposition — color to be approved prior to application by the Lessor or such person or persons designated by Lessor.

5.03 Completion. Cabins must be completed from all outword appearance within one (1) year in time such construction is started. Cabin construction must be started within 1. year inom the date of the signif-Cabin Site Lesse.

5.04 Tree Removal. The Lesses of each cabin site may remove from said site all trees, shrubs, and are the property for building subject to the following conditions:

As required by the State of Washington in the master lesse, any tree whose diameter is over 8" at chest height must be marked by Lessee for Lessor's inspection. Lessor will then notify the Washington State Department of Netural Resources and request their standard appraisal of value. Lessee will then pay Lessor for the value of the tree before removal. Any additional clearing beyond that necessary for the construction of improvements shall be prohibited. The intent is to remove as few trees as possible to the end that the community remain natural and rustic.

5.05 Lot Markers. Lesses will use all reasonable care to make certain that the lot markers, as by Lessor, are not moved or destroyed.

5.06 Improvements Other Than On Cabin Site. No improvements of any kind shell be ex placed upon any area covered by the master lesse without Lessor's prior written consent.

5.07 Ownership of Improvements. The master lesse provides as follows: *8.04 Ownership of Sub-lessee Improvements. All buildings and Improvements, excluding removable personal property and trade fixtures on the lessed site [North Woods] erected by Sub-lessee [Lessee herein] will remain on said site after expiration of this lesse [mester lesse] or termination prior to the term of this lesse [mester lesse] of any sub-lesse [this lesse] held. or termination prior to the term of this lease [master lease] of any sub-lease [this lease] held by the State under the provisions of paragraph 5.09; provided, however, upon the explication of the lease [master lease], if the State is unsuccessful in re-leasing the leased site [North Woods], as a unit, then each sub-lessee [Lessee herein] shall have a preferential right as allowed by law to re-lease from the State its sub-leased area; provided, further, upon the termination or explication of this lease [master lease] or a sub-lease [this lease] assigned under paragraph 5.09 that as a condition of any re-lease of the leased site or sub-leased site to any other party mede during the three year period following the State shall require the subsequent Leases to purchase the Sub-leases's [Lessee herein] interest in the improvements as allowed by law. Expiration, as Sub-lessee's [Lessee herein] interest in the improvements as allowed by law. Expiration, as used in this paragraph, shall mean the expiration of the lease as of May 31, 2025."

The parties hereto agree that the terms and conditions of the above quoted paragraph shall be applicable provide

(a) That Lessee is not in default under any of the terms and conditions of this lesse; and

(b) That Lessee's lease expires May 31, 2025. In the event of earlier expiration of this lesse, all buildings

and improvements located upon the premises shall be the property of Lessor.

The parties hareto further agree that the benefits of paragraph 8.04 of the master lesse shall be enforced to saidly against the State of Washington.

5.00 Takes and Assessments. The Lesses shell pay in annual payments all takes and assessments that are now charged or may become chargeoble against the improvements placed upon the cabin site, now or in the feture, commercing with the takes first becoming due and payable after the date hereof, all before such takes and assessments become pust due.

8.09 North Woods Association. The roads in the plat and certain other common press shall be insid in the name of The North Woods Association, a non-profit association, of which the Lessess of lots in the plat shall be members. Said Association shall be responsible for the maintenance and repair of roads, the entire water system including but not limited to water systems serving the cabins on the premises, docks and common areas and improvements thereing (if any), as well as other community functions which may be given it by its members. The owners (Lesses) of lots in the tract shall be required to pay dues of not less than one and one-half dollars (1%) per month and association. Said dues shall commence at the time 50 lots are lessed. It is understood and agreed that Lessor shall and it is hereby delegated to fulfill all during responsibilities and functions of the North Woods Association until fifty (50) lots in the North Woods are lesses for the purpose of forming said Association.

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SECTION 6. UTILITIES

6.01 Sewage. Individual sewage disposal systems installed by Lessee must be designed, located, and constructed in accordance with the legal regulations, laws and ordinances of Skamania County and the State of Washington.

6.02 Reservation. Lessor reserves to itself and to its successors and assigns easements in, under, and along all roads and other common areas in the plat for any utilities whether presently installed or not. In addition, an essented in an area live (5) feet by ten (10) feet in one corner of each lot (to be selected by Lessor) adjoining the road, for electric transformer vault and/or telephone and power service pedestals if any. And the assignment of the lesse as such may be necessary in the development of this subdivision or adjoining subdivisions.

6.03 Water. Each cabin site has or will be furnished water at or near the lot line. Each lessee as to receive water from the water system supplying the North Woods and further agrees to pay Lessor \$225.00 for the right to

6.04 Maintenance. The lessee shall bear the responsibility and expense of furnishing, installing, back-filling, and mainteining each underground trench or other digging upon such cabin site which is necessary for any utility connections or facilities to serve such cabin site.

SECTION 7. MISCELLANEOUS

7.01 Lessee's Duties. Lessee agrees to comply strictly with the Lessor's rules and regulations and els applicable Federal, State, County, and Municipal laws, rules and regulations relating to all activities contemplated under this lasse, including but not limited to, use of public or private roads, parking, fire and privartion of fire, public health, and pollution of streams or lakes, and to assume all obligations thereby imposed upon the Lessor. Lessor may Impect the cabinate and cabin at any time to determine compliance with the terms of this lease.

7.02 Indemnification. Lessee hereby agrees to assume all risk of, and indemnify and hold harmless, and account of personal injury to or death of any persons whomsoever, including but not limited to employees of the Lessor, or damage to or destruction of property to whomsoever belonging, including but not limited to employees of the Lessor, which might result from Lessee's activities on the lessed premises. The Lessee further agrees to indemnify and save harmless the Lessor from any loss, cost, suit or expense resulting from Lessee's failure to comply with any of the provisions of any applicable laws rules or regulations.

7.03 triburance. Lessee shall obtain fire, casualty and liability insurance as follows:

(a) Fire and casualty insurance in a sufficient amount to cover the replacement cost of any or all improvements upon the lessed premises. Such insurance shall be carried by a responsible company or companies satisfactor to Lessor and the policy or policies shall be endorsed and delivered to Lessor with provision for thirty (30) days:

(b) Liability and property insurance insuring Lessor and Lessee against all liability for damages to persons or property caused by the maintenance, use or occupancy of the lessed premises or by reason of the conduct of any activity carried on therain. Such insurance shall be carried by a responsible company or companies satisfactory so Lessor in amounts not less than the following limits, namely:

Bodily injury to or death of any one person, \$5,000,00; Bodily injury or death resulting from any one accident to two or more persons, \$10,000,00; and

Lesses shall deliver to Lessor certificates and receipts evidencing said policies of insurance and further provide with the company or companies for thirty (30) days' notice of cancellation to Lessor.

7.04 Assignment. Without the prior written consent of Lessor, Lessoe shell not assign this lesso or an interest therein, of subject, and no heir, executor, administrator, receiver, trustee in bankruptcy or other assignee by open of law shall assign or subjects without such written consent.

7.05 Waiver. Any waiver by the Lessor of any provisions hereof must be in writing, and any of the contents, conditions, restrictions, in this lease may be annulled, waived, changed, or modified with respect to all or any portions.

7.06 Attorneys' Fees. In the event any action, suit, proceeding or appeal therefrom is brought to collect the rent due or to become due hereunder, or any portion thereof, or to get possession of said premises, or to enforce compliance with this lease, or for failure to observe any of the covenants of this lease, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover such sum as the Court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys' fees to be allowed in said suit, action, proceeding or appeal therefrom its arbitrary of the court.

7.07. Condemnation. The parties hereto shall receive any sums or damages paid or awarded by reseon of any taking, condemnation or acquisition during the existence of this lease as their interests therein shall then appear, whether public or private, of any title to or interest in all or

7.08 Reservoir Level. The Lessee acknowledges by signing this fease that Pacific Power and Light Company has the right to fluctuate the waters of Swift Reservoir at any time within the provisions of Federal Power Commission License No. 2111 or as amended. The Lessee shall waive all claims or damage and shall indemnify Pacific Power and Light Company, the State of Washington, Lessor or their successors, if any, against any claim of damage arising from fluctuation in reservoir level or impairment of recreational use of the reservoir or shoreside or floating facilities.

7.09 Validity of Provisions. The determination of any Court that any provisions of this lease are or void shall not affect the validity of any other provision hereof.

7.10 Enforcement of Restrictions. Without in any way limiting the rights of Lessor if the

whom the provisions hereof are binding, or any of them, shall violate or attempt to violate any of the reservations, restrictions or covernants hereof, the Lessor or any lessee of land in the tract, shall have the right to compel performance of or compliance with the provisions hereof, to abate and remove, at the expense of the offending lessee or lossees of the property, violation of the provisions hereof and to prosecute any proceedings at law or in equity in furtherance of the eforesaid remedies in any Court having jurisdiction of such cases.

7.11 Reservations on Land. All of the reservations, conditions, covenants, agreements and restrictions under them and on all property within the tract.

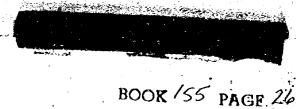
