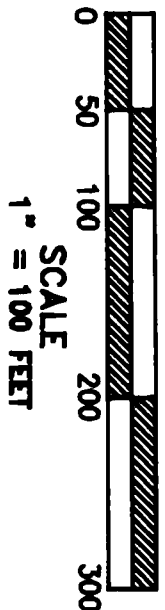
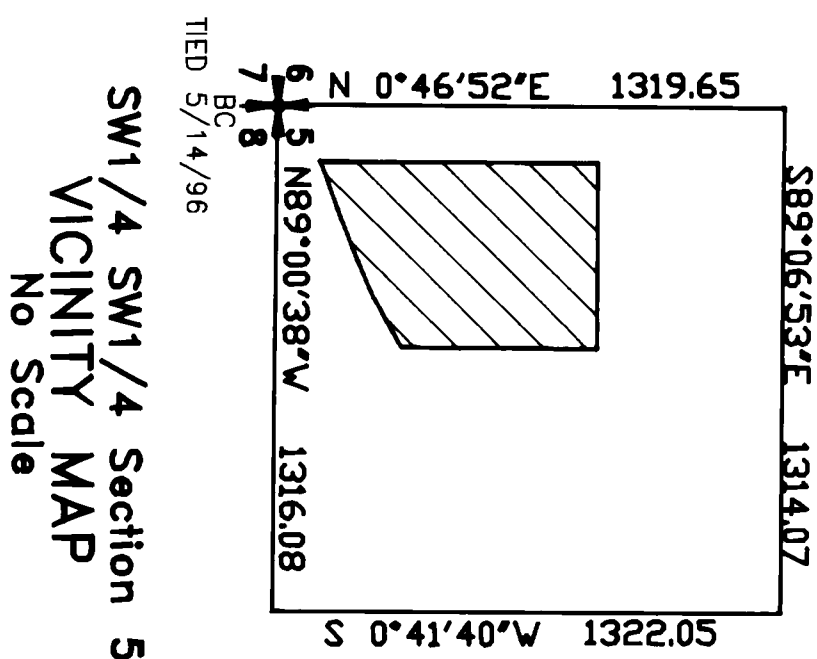


SURVEY IN SW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ SEC. 5, T.1 N., R.5 E., W.M.

TRAVERSE STATEMENT & SURVEY NARRATIVE: A closed field traverse for the parcel shown was made with a ten-second total station and related measuring equipment, all of which met state standards (WAC 332-130-090) at the time of this survey. Acceptable raw angular and distance closures in excess of 1:5000 were balanced by compass adjustment where necessary to effect mathematical closure. No encroachments were noted during this survey, the purpose of which was to set property corners and mark the north and west lines for fence construction. Field work was conducted during the period between May 7 and July 18, 1996.

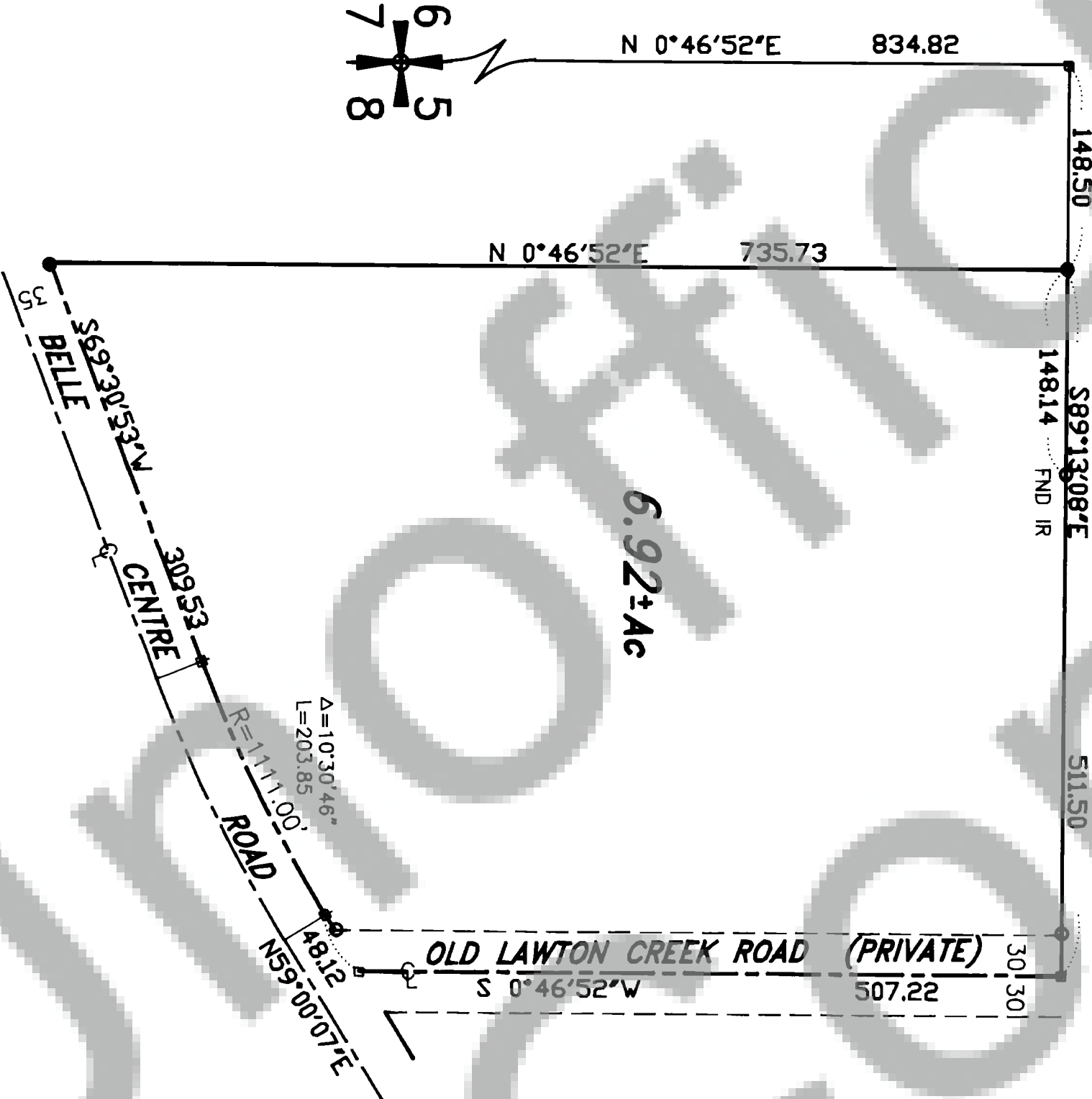
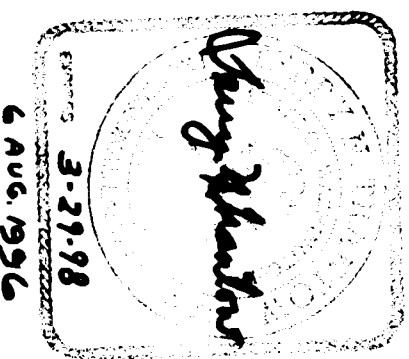
