Credit Union may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the Indebtedness or the restoration and repair of the Property. 4.4 Compliance with Prior Indebtedness. During the period in which any prior Indebtedness described in Section 17 is in effect, compliance with the insurance provisions contained in the instrument evidencing such prior Indebtedness shall constitute compliance with the insurance provisions under this Deed of Trust, to the extent compliance with the terms of this Deed of Trust would constitute a duplication of insurance requirements. If any proceeds from the insurance become payable on loss, the provisions in this Deed of Trust for division of proceeds shall apply only to that portion of the proceeds not payable to the holder of the prior Indebtedness. 4.5 Association of Unit Owners. Amounts so added shall be payable on demand with interest from the which Credit Union may be entitled on account of the default. Credit Union shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Credit Union may be entitled on account of the default. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's title or the interest of Credit Union or Trustee under this Deed of Trust, Grantor shall defend the action at Grantor's expense. 7. Condemnation. 7.1 Application of Net Proceeds. If all or any part of the Property is condemned, Credit Union, has at its election require that all or any tion of the net proceeds of the award shall mean the award after payment of all sounds costs, expenses, and attorneys' fees necessarily paid or incurred by Grantor, Credit Union, or Treatee in connection with the demnation. 7.2 Proceedings. If any proceedings in condemnation are filed, Grantor shall promptly notify Credit Union in writing and Grantor shall promptly take such steps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the award. 8. Imposition of Tax By State. State Taxes Covered. The following shall constitute state taxes to which this section applies:

(a) A specific tax upon trust deeds or upon all or any part of the Indebtedness secured by a trust deed or security agreement.

(b) A specific tax on a Grantor which the taxpayer is authorized or required to deduct from payments on the Indebtedness secured by a trust deed or security agreement.

(c) A tax on a trust deed or security agreement chargeable against the Credit Union or the holder of the note secured. (d) A specific tax on all or any portion of the Indebtedness or on payments of principal and interest made by a Grantor. 8.2 Remedies. If any state tax to which this section applies is enacted subsequent to the date of this Deed of Trust, this shall have the same effect as a default, and Credit Union may exercise any or all of the remedies available to it in the event of a default unless the following conditions (a) Grantor may lawfully pay the tax or charge imposed by the state tax, and
(b) Grantor pays or offers to pay the tax or charge within 30 days after notice from Credit Union that the tax law has been enacted Power and Obligations of Trustee. Power and Onigations of argustes.

Powers of Trustee. In addition to all powers of Trustee arising as a matter of law, Trustee shall have the power to take the following with respect to the Property upon the request of Credit Union and Grantor:

(a) Join in preparing and filing a map or plat of the Real Property, including the dedication of streets or other rights in the public.

(b) Join in granting any easement or creating any restriction on the Real Property.

(c) Join in any subordination or other agreement affecting this Deed of Trust or the interest of Credit Union under this Deed of Trust.

Obligations to Notify. Trustee shall not be obligated to notify any other party of a pending sale under any other trust deed or lien, or of the proceeding in which Grantor, Credit Union, or Trustee shall be a party, unless the action or proceeding is brought by Trustee. 10. Transfer by Grantor. 10.1 Consent by Credit Union. Grantor shall not transfer or agree to transfer all or part of Grantor's interest in the Property without the or written consent of Credit Union. Any attempt to transfer shall constitute a default under this Deed of Trust. A "sale or transfer," means the

Service And Parket conveyance of the Real Property or any right, title, or interest therein, whether legal or equitable, whether voluntary or involuntary, by outright sale, deed, installment sale contract, land contract, contract for deed, leasehold interest with a term greater than three years, lease-option contract, or any other method of conveyance of real property interests. If any Borrower is a corporation, transfer also includes any change in ownership of more than 25% of the voting stock of Borrower.

If Grantor or a prospective transferred applies to Credit Union for consent to a transfer, Credit Union may require such information concerning the prospective transferred as weald cormally be required from a new loan applicant.

10.2 Condition to Consent. As a condition of its consent to any transfer, Credit Union may in its discretion impose an assumption fee in accordance with Credit Union's fee schedule then in effect, and may increase the interest rate of the Indebtedness to the prevailing rate for similar rates then charged by Credit Union. Credit Union may increase the amount of each remaining installment so that the Indebtedness will be fully paid by the original maturity date. In no event, however, shall the interest rate be increased, nor any fee imposed, beyond the maximum rate permitted under applicable law. This paragraph sets forth terms that Credit Union may impose as a condition to consent. This paragraph is not exclusive and Credit Union at its sole discretion, may impose additional terms or may decline to consent to other transfer.

10.3 Effect of Consent. If Credit Union consents to one transfer, that consents thall not constitute a consent to other transfer or a majure. 10.3 Effect of Consent. If Credit Union consents to one transfer, that consent shall not constitute a consent to other transfers or a waiver of this section. No transfer by Grantor shall relieve Grantor of liability for payment of the Indebtedness. Following a transfer, Credit Union may agree to any extension of time for payment or modification of the terms of this Deed of Trust or the Note or waive any right or remedy under this Deed of Trust or the Note without relieving Grantor from liability. Grantor waives notice, presentment, and protest with respect to the Indebtedness. 11. Security Agreement; Financing Statements. 11.1 Security Agreement. This instrument shall constitute a security agreement to the extent any of the Property constitutes fixtures, and Credit Union shall have all of the rights of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code of the state in which the Real Property is located. Grantor will reimburse Credit Union for all expenses incurred in perfecting or continuing this security interest. Upon default, Grantor shall assemble the Personal Property and make it available to Credit Union within three days after receipt of written demand from Credit Union. assemble the Personal Property and make it available to Credit Union within three days after receipt of written demand from Credit Union.

11.3 Mobile Homes. Any reconveyance fee or termination fee required by law shall be paid by Grantor. 13. Default. The following shall constitute events of default:

(a) Failure of Grantor to pay any portion of the Indebtedness when it is due.

(b) Failure of Grantor within the time required by this Deed of Trust to make any payment for taxes, insurance, or for any other payment necessary to prevent filing of or to affect discharge of any lien.

(c) Dissolution or termination of existence (if Grantor is a corporation), insolvency, business failure, appointment of a receiver for any part of the Property of, assignment for the benefit of creditors by, the commencement of any proceeding under any bankruptcy or insolvency laws by or against, or the failure to obtain dismissel or deny the contents of any petition filed under any bankruptcy or insolvency laws within the time required to answer by, Grantor or any of the individuals or entities who are herein collectively referred to as "Grantor." insolvency laws within the time required to answer by, Grantor or any of the individuals or entities who are neven conecuvery reterred to as "Grantor."

(d) Default of Grantor under any prior obligation or instrument securing any prior obligation, or commencement of any suit or other action to forecless any prior lien.

(e) If the Real Property has been submitted to unit ownership pursuant to a Unit Ownership Law or any similar law, failure of Grantor to perform any of the obligations imposed on Grantor by the declaration submitting the Real Property to unit ownership, by the bylaws of the association of unit owners, or by any rules or regulations thereunder. (1) Credit Union has sent to Grantor a written notice of the failure and the failure has not been cured within 15 days of the notice, or if the default cannot be cured within 15 days, Grantor has not commenced curative action or is not diligently pursuing such curative action, or if the default connot be cared within 15 days, Grantor has not commenced carative action or is not disigently pursuing such carative action or (2) Grantor has given notice of a breach of the same provision(s) of this Deed of Trust within the preceding 12 months.

(g) If the interest of Grantor in the Property is a leasehold interest, any default by Grantor under the terms of the lease, or any other event (whether or not the fault of Grantor) that results in the termination of Grantor's leasehold rights, provided, that such event shall not constitute a default if Grantor provides Credit Union with prior written notice reasonably satisfactory to Credit Union setting forth Grantor intent to place the Personal Property and all Improvements at another location, subject to a lease of at least equal benefit to Grantor of the terminated lease, stating the location, and evidencing Grantor's right to do so.

(b) Any breach by Grantor under the terms of any other agreement between Grantor and Credit Union that is not remedied within any grace period provided therein, including without limitation any agreement concerning any indebtedness of Grantor to Credit Union, whether made now or later.

(i) If Credit Union reasonably deems itself insecure. 14. Remedies. Upon the occurrence of say event of default and at any time thereafter, Trustee or Credit Union may declare a default and at case any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law:

(a) Credit Union shall have the right at its option without notice to Grantor to declare the entire Indebtedness immediately due and payable, including any prepayment penalty which Grantor would be required to pay.

(b) With respect to all or any part of the Real Property, the Trustee shall have the right to foreclose by notice and sale, and Credit Union shall have the right to foreclose by indicial foreclosure, in either case in accordance with and to the full extent provided by applicable law.

(c) With respect to all or any part of the Personal Property, Credit Union shall have all the rights and remedies of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code in effect in the state in which the Property is located.

(d) Credit Union shall have the right, without notice to Grantor, to take possession of the Property and collect the Income, including amounts past due and anpaid, and apply the net proceeds over and above Credit Union access, against the Indebtedness. In furtherance of this right, Credit Union may require any tenant or other user to credit Union and Grantor in the name of Grantor and to negotiate the same and collect the proceeds Payments by tenants or other users to Credit Union in response to Credit Union's demand shall satisfy the obligation for which the payments are made, whether or not any proper groands for the demand existed. Credit Union may exercise its rights under this subparagraph either in person, by agent, or through a receiver.

(e) Credit Union shall have the right to have a receiver appointed to take possession of any or all of the Property, with the power to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the Property preceding foreclosure or alle, and to collect the Income from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and a Rights and Remedies on Default. (g) If the Real Property is submitted to unit ewnership, Credit Union or its designee may vote on any matter that may come before the members of the association of unit owners, parsuant to the power of attorney granted Credit Union in Section 16.2.
(h) Trustee and Credit Union shall have any other right or remedy provided in this Deed of Trust, or the Note. 14.2 Sale of the Property. In exercising its rights and remedies, the Trustee or Credit Union, shall be free to sell all or any part of the Property together or separately, or to sell certain portions of the Property and refrain from selling other portions. Credit Union shall be entitled to bid at any public sale on all or any portion of the Property. 14.3 Notice of Sale. Credit Union shall give Grantor reasonable notice of the time and place of any public sale of the Personal Property or of time after which any private sale or other intended disposition of the Personal Property is to be made. Reasonable notice shall mean notice at a teast ten days before the time of the sale or disposition. 14.4 Waiver, Election of Remedies. A waiver by any party of a breach of a provision of this Deed of Trust shall not constitute a waiver of prejudice the party's right otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. Election by Credit Union to pursue any remedy shall not exclude pursuit of any other remedy, and an election to make expenditures or take action to perform an obligation of Grantor beed of Trust after failure of Grantor to perform shall not affect Credit Union's right to declare a default and exercise its remedies under this Deed of Trust. 14.5 Attorneys' Fees; Expenses. If Credit Union institutes any suit or action to enforce any of the terms of this Deed of Trust, Credit Union shall be entitled to recover such sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys' fees at trial and on any appeal. Whether or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expenses incurred by Credit Union that are necessary at any time in Credit Union's opinion for the protection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the Indebtedness payable on demand and shall bear interest from the date of expenditure until repaid at the rate of the Note. Expenses covered by this paragraph include (without limitation) all attorney fees incurred by reports, appraisal fees, title insurance, and fees for the Trustee. Attorney fees include those for bankruptcy proceedings and anticipated post judgment collection actions. 15. Notice. Any notice under this Deed of Trust shall be in writing and shall be effective when actually delivered or, if mailed, shall be deemed effective on the second day after being deposited as first-class registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, directed to the address stated in this Deed of Trust. Any party may change its address for notices by written notice to the other parties. Credit Union's address that copies of notices of foreclosure from the holder of any lien which has priority over this Deed of Trust be sent to Credit Union's address, as set forth on page one of this Deed of Trust. If the Property is in California, the notice shall be as provided by Section 2924b of the Civil Code of California.

## 16 Miscellaneous.

- 16 1 Successors and Assigns. Subject to the limitations stated in this Deed of Trust on transfer of Grantor's interest, and subject to the provisions of applicable law with respect to successor trustees, this Deed of Trust shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties, their successors and assigns.
- 16.2. Unit Ownership Power of Attorney. If the Real Property is submitted to unit ownership Grantor grants an irrevocable power of orney to Credit Union to vote in its discretion on any matter that may come before the members of the association of unit owners. Credit Union all have the right to exercise this power, as Credit Union may left.
