- 6. Breach: After the effective date of this agreement, any change in use of the land, except through compliance with items (5), (7), or (9), shall be considered a breach of this agreement, and shall be subject to removal of classification and liable for applicable taxes, penalties, and interest as provided in RCW 84.34.080 and RCW 84.34.108.
- 7. A breach of agreement shall not have occurred and the additional tax shall not be imposed if removal of classification resulted solely from:
 - (a) Transfer to a governmental entity in exchange for other land located within the State of Wachington.
 - (b) A taking through the exercise of the power of eminent domain, or sale or transfer to an entity having the power in anticipation of the exercise of such power and having manifested its intent in writing or by other official action.
 - (c) A natural disaster such as a flood, windstorm, earthquake, or other such calamity rather than by virtue of the act of the landowner changing the use of such property.
 - (d) Official action by an agency of the State of Washington or by the county or city where the land is located disallowing the present use of such land.
 - (e) Transfer of land to a church when such land would qualify for exemption pursuant to RCW \$4.36.020.
 - (f) Acquisition of property interests by State agencies or agencies or organizations qualified under RCW 84.34.210 and 64.04.130 (See RCW 84.34108(5)(f)).
- (g) Removal of land classified as farm and agricultural land under RCW 84.34.020(2)(d).
- The county assessor may require an owner to submit data relevant to continuing the eligibility of any parcel of land described in this agreement.
- 9. Reclassification as provided in Chapter 84.34 RCW.

This agreement shall be subject to the following conditions:

- Management of the subject parcel shall proceed as outlined in the applicant's Forest Management Plan.
- All recommendations set out in the Forest Management Plan shall be requirements and shall be executed as specified in
- Within three years of any harvest, the harvest area should be replanted to 12' x 12' spacing or contain at least 100 trees/acre of at least 20 years of age.
- Since this application and Forest Management Plan is specific to the entire parcel, any further division of the subject parcel shall require a new management plan specific to each parcel.
- ds and brush shall be suppressed until all trees exceed 6' in neight.

It is declared that this agreement specifies the classification and conditions as provided for in CH.84.34 RCW and the conditions imposed by this Granting Authority. This agreement to tax according to the use of the property may be annulled or canceled at any time by the Legislature.
