- Except those which are necessary for construction purposes, all existing oak and conifer trees shall be retained and maintained in a healthy condition.
- All oak and conifer trees that should die or are otherwise damaged, including those 2) which are necessary for construction purposes, shall be replaced in kind.
- The following procedures shall be effected when cultural resources are discovered 5) during construction activities.

- Halt Construction. All construction activities within 100 feet of the discovered cultural resource shall cease. The cultural resources shall remain as found; further disturbance is prohibited.
- b) Notification. The project applicant shall notify the Planning Department and the Gorge Commission within 24 hours of the discovery. If the cultural resources are prehistoric or otherwise associated with Native Americans, the project applicant shall also notify the Indian tribal governments within 24 hours.
- Survey and Evaluations. The Gorge Commission shall arrange for the cultural resources survey.

#### **NOTES**

Any new residential development, related accessory structures such as garages or workshops, and additions or alterations not included in the approved site plan, will require a new application and review.

As per SCC §22.06.050(C)(2), the Director's Decision shall be recorded in the County deed records prior to commencement of the approved project.

As per SCC §22.06.050(C)(5), the decision of the Director approving a proposed development action shall become void in two years if the development is not commenced within that period, or when the development action is discontinued for any reason for one continuous year or more.

#### APPEALS

The decision of the Director shall be final unless a written Notice of Appeal is filed by an interested person within 20 days from the date hereof. Appeal may be made to the Skamania County Board of Adjustment, P.O. Box 790, Stevenson, WA 98648. Notice of Appeal forms are available at the Department Office.
