CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL:

- The garage/workshop shall be consistent with the enclosed site plan, unless modified by the following conditions of approval. If modified, the site plan shall be consistent with the conditions of approval.
- The garage/workshop shall be setback five feet from the side lot lines, fifteen feet from the 2) rear lot line, and fifteen feet from the front lot line or forty-five feet from the centerline of private or public road, whichever is greater.
- The garage/workshop shall be finished in the same nonreflective, dark materials as the existing home.

- The following procedures shall be effected when cultural resources are discovered during construction activities.
 - Halt Construction. All construction activities within 100 feet of the discovered a) cultural resource shall cease. The cultural resources shall remain as found; further disturbance is prohibited.
 - Notification. The project applicant shall notify the Planning Department and the b) Gorge Commission within 24 hours of the discovery. If the cultural resources are prehistoric or otherwise associated with Native Americans, the project applicant shall also notify the Indian tribal governments within 24 hours.
 - Survey and Evaluations. The Gorge Commission shall arrange for the cultural C) resources survey.
