- 4.2 Application of Proceeds. Grantor shall promptly notify Credit Union of any loss or damage to the Property. Credit Union may make proof of loss if Grantor fails to do so within 15 days of the casualty. Credit Union may, this election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the Indettedness or the restoration and repair of the Property. If Credit Union elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repair, Grantor shall repair or replace the damaged or destroyed Improvements in a manner satisfactory to Credit Union, shall upon satisfactory proof of such expenditure, pay or reinburse Grantor from the proceeds for the reasonable cost of repair or restoration if Grantor is not in default hereunder.
