- 3.3 Evidence of Payment. Grantor shall upon demand furnish to Credit Union evidence of payment of the taxes of assessments and shall authorize the appropriate county official to deliver to Credit Union at any time a written and the taxes and assessments against the Property.
- 3.4 Notice of Construction. Grantor shall notify Credit Union at least 15 days before any work is commenced, any services are furnished, or any materials are supplied to the Property if a construction lien could be asserted on account of the work, services, or materials and the cost exceeds \$5,000 (if the Property is used for non residential or commercial purposes) or \$1,000 (if the Property is used as a residence). Grantor will on request furnish improvements.
- 3.5 Tax Reserves. Subject to any limitations set by applicable law, Credit Union may require Borrower to maintain with Credit Union reserves for payment of taxes and assessments, which reserves shall be created by advance payment or monthly payments of a sum estimated by Credit Union to be sufficient to produce, at least style days before due, amounts at least squal to the taxes and assessments to be paid. If 15 days before payment is due the reserve funds are insufficient, Borrower shall upon demand pay any deficiency to Credit Union. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a Application of the property of the property
- 4.2 Application of Proceeds. Grantor shall promptly notify Credit Union of any loss or damage to the Property. Credit Union may make proof of loss if Grantor fails to do so within 15 days of the casualty. Credit Union may make proof of loss if Grantor fails to do so within 15 days of the casualty. Credit Union may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the Indebtedness or the restoration and repair of the damaged or destroyed Improvements in a manner satisfactory to Credit Union. - 4.4 Compliance with Prior Indebtedness. During the period in which any prior Indebtedness described in Section 17 is in effect, compliance with the insurance provisions contained in the instrument evidencing such prior compliance with the terms of this Deed of Trust to the extent holder of the prior indebtedness.
- 4.5 Association of Unit Owners. If 15 days before payment is due the reserve funds are insufficient, Borrower shall upon demand pay any deficiency to Credit Union. The reserve funds shall be held by Credit Union as a general deposit from Borrower and shall constitute a noninterest bearing debt from Credit Union to Borrower, which Credit Union may satisfy by payment of the insurance premiums required to be paid by Borrower as they become due. Credit Union does not hold the reserve funds in trust for Borrower, and Credit Union is not the agent of Borrower for payment of the insurance premiums required to be paid by the Borrower.
- 5. Expenditure by Credit Union. If Grantor fails to comply with any provision of this Deed of Trust, including the obligation to maintain the prior Indebtedness in good standing as required by Section 17, Credit Union may at its option on Grantor's behalf pay amounts to cure any defaults in the prior indebtedness and any amount that in expends in so doing shall be added to the Indebtedness. Amounts so added shall be payable in accordance with the terms of the indebtedness. The rights provided for in this section shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Credit Union may be entitled on account of the default. Credit Union shall not by taking the required action cure the default so as to bar it from any remedy that it otherwise would have had.

- 7. Condemnation.
 7.1 Application of Net Proceeds: If all or any part of the Property is condemned, Credit Union may at its election require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the award be applied to the Indebtedness. The net proceeds of the award shall mean the award after payment of all reasonable costs, expenses, and attorneys' fees necessarily paid or incurred by Grantor, Credit Union, or Trustee in connection with the condemnation.
 7.2 Proceedings. If any proceedings in condemnation are filed, Grantor shall promptly notify Credit Union in writing and Grantor shall promptly take such steps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the award.

- Imposition of Tax By State.
- State Taxes Covered. The following shall constitute state taxes to which this section applies:
 - (a) A specific tax upon trust deeds or upon all or any part of the indebtedness secured by a trust deed or

- 9.1 Powers of Trustee. In addition to all powers of Trustee arising as a matter of law, Trustee shall have the er to take the following actions with respect to the Property upon the request of Credit Union and Grantor:

 - (a) Join in preparing and filing a map or plat of the Real Property, including the dedication of streets or other rights in the public.

 (b) Join in granting any easement or creating any restriction on the Real Property.

 (c) Join in any subordination or other agreement affecting this Deed of Trust or the interest of Credit Union under this Deed of Trust.
- 9.2 Obligations to Notify. Trustee shall not be obligated to notify any other party of a pending sale under any other trust deed or lien, or of any action or proceeding in which Grantor, Credit Union, or Trustee shall be a party, unless the action or proceeding is brought by Trustee.
 - 10. Transfer by Grantor.
- 10.1 Consent by Credit Union. Grantor shall not transfer or agree to transfer all or part of Grantor's interest in the Property without the prior written consent of Credit Union. Any attempt to transfer shall entitle the Credit Union to terminate and accelerate the indebtedness under this Deed of Trust.

 A "sale or transfer" means the conveyance of real property or any right, title, or interest therin, whether legal or equitable, whether voluntary or involuntary, by outright sale, deed, installment sale contract, land contract, contract for deed, leasehold interest with a term greater than three years, lease-option contract, or any other method of conveyance of real property interest.  - 11. Security Agreement; Financing Statements.
- 11.1 Security Agreement. This instrument shall constitute a security agreement to the extent any of the Property constitutes fectures, and Credit Union shall have all of the rights of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code of the state in which the Real Property is located.

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- 11.2 Security Interest. Upon request by Credit Union, Grantor shall execute financing statements and take whatever other action is requested by Credit Union to perfect and continue to perfect or continue this security interest in the Income and Personal Property. Grantor hereby appoints Credit Union as Grantor's attorney in fact for the purpose of executing any documents necessary to perfect or continue this security interest. Credit Union may, at any time and without further authorization from Grantor, file occupies or reproductions of this Deed of Trust as a financing statement. Grantor will reimburse Credit Union for all expenses incurred in perfecting or continuing this security interest. Upon default, Grantor shall assemble the Personal Property and make it available to Credit Union within three days after receipt of written demand from Credit Union.
- 11.3 Mobile Homes. If the Property includes mobile homes, motor homes, or similar structures, such structures shall be and shall remain Personal Property or Real Property as stated above regardless of whether such structures are airlived to the Real Property, and irrespective of the classification of such structures for the purpose of tax assessments. The removal or addition of axles or wheels, or the placement upon or removal from a concrete base, shall not alter the characterization of such structures.
- 12. Reconveyance on Full Performance. If Grantor pays all of the Indebtedness when due and otherwise performs all the obligations imposed upon Grant's under this Deed of Trust and the Agreement. Credit Union shall execute and deliver to Trustee a request for full reconveyance and shall execute and deliver to Grantor suitable statements of termination of any financing statement on file evidencing Credit Union's security interest in the income and the Personal Property. Any reconveyance fee or termination fee required by law shall be paid by Grantor.
- 13. Possible Actions of Credit Union.

 The Credit Union may take the following actions with respect to your Agreement under the circumstances listed below:

 a. Termination and Acceleration. The Credit Union may terminate your Agreement and require Grantor to pay the entire outstanding balance immediately, and charge Grantor certain fees if any of the following
- happen:

 (1) Grantor engages in any fraud or material misrepresentation in connection with the Agreement.

 For example, if there are false statements or omissions on Grantor's application or financial statements.

 (2) Grantor does not meet the repayment terms of the Agreement.

 (3) Grantor's actions or inactions adversely affect the collateral or Credit Union's rights in the collateral. For example, if Grantor fails to: maintain insurance, pay taxes; transfer title to or sell the collateral, prevent the foreclosure of any items, or waste of the collateral.
- b. Suspension of Credit/Reduction of Credit Limit. Credit Union may refuse to make additional advances on the line of credit or reduce the credit limit during any period in which the following exist or
- (1) Any of the circumstances listed in a., above.
 (2) The value of Grantor's dwelling securing the Indebtness declines significantly below its appraised as of the Agreement.
- (3) Credit Union reasonably believes that Grantor will not be able to meet the repayment requirements of the Agreement due to a material change in Grantor's financial circumstances.

 (4) Grantor(s) are in default under any material obligation of the Agreement and Deed of Trust.

 (5) The maximum annual percentage rate under the Agreement is reached.

 (6) Any government action prevents Credit Union from imposing the annual percentage rate provided for or impairs Credit Union's security interest such that the value of the interest is less than 120 percent of the credit line. (7) Credit Union has been notified by government agency that continued advances would constitute
- c. Change in Terms. The Agreement permits Credit Union to make certain changes to the terms of the Agreement at specified times or upon the occurrence of specified events.
 - 14. Actions Upon Termination.
- 14.1 Remedies. Upon the occurence of any termination and at any time thereafter, Trustee or Credit Union exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, at administration (a) With respect to all or any part of the Real Property, the Trustee shall have the right to foreclose by notice and sale, and Credit Union shall have the rights to foreclosure by judicial foreclosure, in either case in accordance with and to the full extent provided by applicable law.

Election by Credit Union to pursue any remedy shall not exclude pursuit of any other remedy, and an election to make expenditures or take action to perform an obligation of Grantor under this Deed of Trust after failure of Grantor to perform shall not affect Credit Union's right to take actions on the Indebtedness and exercise its remedies under this Deed of Trust.
- 14.5 Attorneys' Fees; Expenses. If Credit Union institutes any suit or action to enforce any of the terms of this Deed of Trust, Credit Union shall be entitled to recover such sum as the coult may adjudge reasonable as attorneys' fees at trial and on any appeal. Whether or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expenses incurred by Credit Union that are necessary at any time in Credit Union's opinion for the protection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the Indebtedness payable on demand and shall bear interest from the date of expenditure until repaid at the rate of the Agreement. Expenses covered by this paragraph include (without limitation) all attorney fees incurred by Credit Union whether or not there is a lawsuit, the cost of searching records, obtaining title reports (including foreclosure reports), surveyors' reports, appraisal fees, title insurance and fees for the Trustee.

Fees include those for bankruptcy proceedings and anticipated post-judgement actions,

- 15. Notice. Any notice under this Deed of Trust shall be in writing and shall be effective when actually delivered, or, if mailed, shall be deemed effective on the second day after being deposited as first-class registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, directed to the address stated in this Deed of Trust. Unless otherwise required by applicable law, any party may change its address for notices by written notice to the other parties. Credit Union requests that copies of notices of foreclosure from the holder of any lien which has priority over this Deed of Trust be sent to Credit Union's address, as set forth on page one of this Deed of Trust. If the Property is in California, the notice shall be as provided by Section 2924b of the Civil Code of California. If this property is in Virginia, the following notice applies: NOTICE THE DEBT SECURED HEREBY IS SUBJECT TO CALL IN FULL OR THE TERMS THEREOF MODIFIED IN THE EVENT OF SALE OR CONVEYANCE OF THE PROPERTY CONVEYED.
 - 16. Miscellaneous.
- 16.1 Successors and Assigns. Subject to the limitations stated in this Deed of Trust on transfer of Grantor's interest, and subject to the provisions of applicable law with respect to successor trustees, this Deed of Trust shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties, their successors and assigns.
- 16.2 Unit Ownership Power of Attorney. If the Real Property is submitted to unit ownership, Grantor an irrevocable place of attorney to Credit Union to vote in its discretion on any matter that may come before the members of the association of unit owners. Credit Union shall have the right to exercise this power of attorney only after default by Grantor and may decline to exercise this power as Credit Union may see fit.
- 16.3 Annual Reports. If the Property is used for purposes other than grantor's residence, within 60 days following the close of each fiscal year of Grantor, Grantor shall furnish to Credit Union a statement of net operating income received from the Property during Grantor's previous fiscal year in such detail as Credit Union shall require. "Net operating income" shall mean all cash receipts from the Property less all cash expenditures made in connection with the operation of the Property.
- 16.4 Applicable Law. The law of the state in which the Property is located shall be applicable for the purpose of construing and determining the validity of this Deed of Trust and, determining the rights and remedies of Credit Union on default.
- 16.5 Joint and Several Liability. If Grantor consists of more than one person or entity, the obligations sed upon Grantor under this Deed of Trust shall be joint and several.
 - 16.6 Time of Essence. Time is of the essence of this Deed of Trust.

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- (a) If located in Idaho, the Property either is not more than twenty acres in area or is located within an incorporated city or village.

 (b) If located in Washington, the Property is not used principally for agricultural or farming purposes.

 (c) If located in Montana, the Property does not exceed fifteen acres and this instrument is a Trust Indenture executed in conformity with the Small Tract Financing Act of Montana.

 (d) If located in Utah, this instrument is a Trust Deed executed in conformity with the Utah Trust Deed Act.

- 16.6 Waiver of Homestead Exemption. Borrower hereby waives the benefit of the homestead exemption as to all sums secured by this Deed of Trust.
- 16.9 Merger. There shall be no merger of the interest of estate created by this Deed of Trust with any interest or estate in the Property at any time held by or for the benefit of Credit Union in any capacity, without t consent of Credit Union

 16.10 Substitute Trustee. Credit Union, at Credit Union's option, may from time to time appoint a successor trustee to any Trustee appointed hereunder by an instrument executed and acknowledged by Credit Union and recorded in the office of the Recorder of the county where the Property is located. The instrument shall contain the name of the original Credit Union, Trustee, and Borrower, the book and page where this Deed of Trust is recorded, and the name and address of the successor trustee. The successor trustee shall, without conveyance of the Property, succeed to all the title, powers, and duties conferred upon the Trustee herein and by applicable law. This procedure for substitution of trustee shall govern to the exclusion of all other provisions for substitution.
