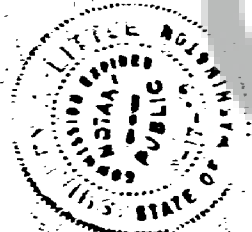

Range

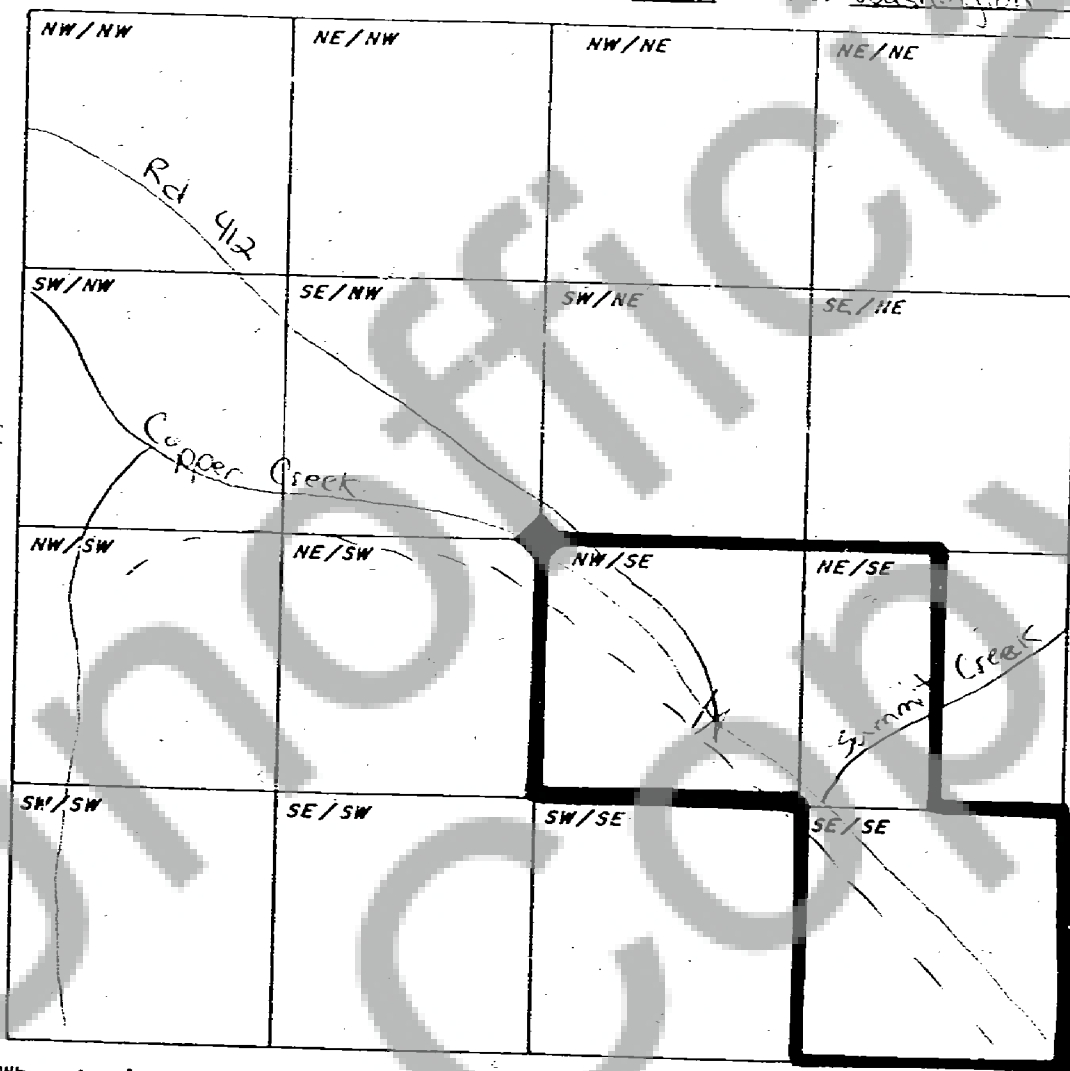
