(1) Grantor engages in any fraud or material misrepresentation in connection with the Agreement. For example, if there are false statements or omissions on Grantor's application or financial statements.

(2) Grantor does not meet the repayment ferms of the Agreement.

(3) Grantor's actions or inactions adversely affect the collisteral or Credit Union's rights in the collateral. For example, if Grantor fails b. Supplement or Credit Peduction of Credit Union any refuse to make additional advances on the line of credit or reduce the credit limit during any period in which the following exist or occur:

(1) Any of the circumstances listed in a., above.

(2) The value of Grantor's dwelling securing the Indebtedness declines significantly below its appraised value for purposes of the Agreement.
