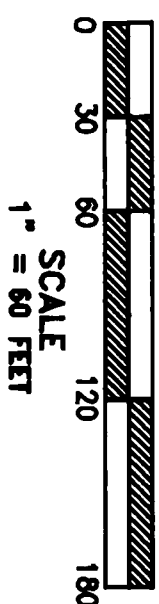

TRAVERSE STATEMENT & SURVEY NARRATIVE: A closed field traverse for the parcel shown was made with a five-second total station and related measuring equipment, all of which met State standards of WAC 332-130 at the time of this survey. Acceptable raw angular and distance closures in excess of 1:10000 were obtained and no adjustments were needed or made. An old gravel pit encroachment found during the field survey is noted approximately as shown. Field work was conducted during the period of August 19 - September 4, 1997.

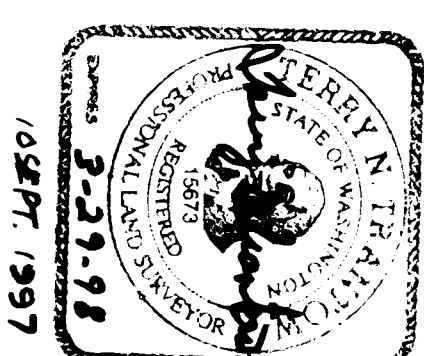
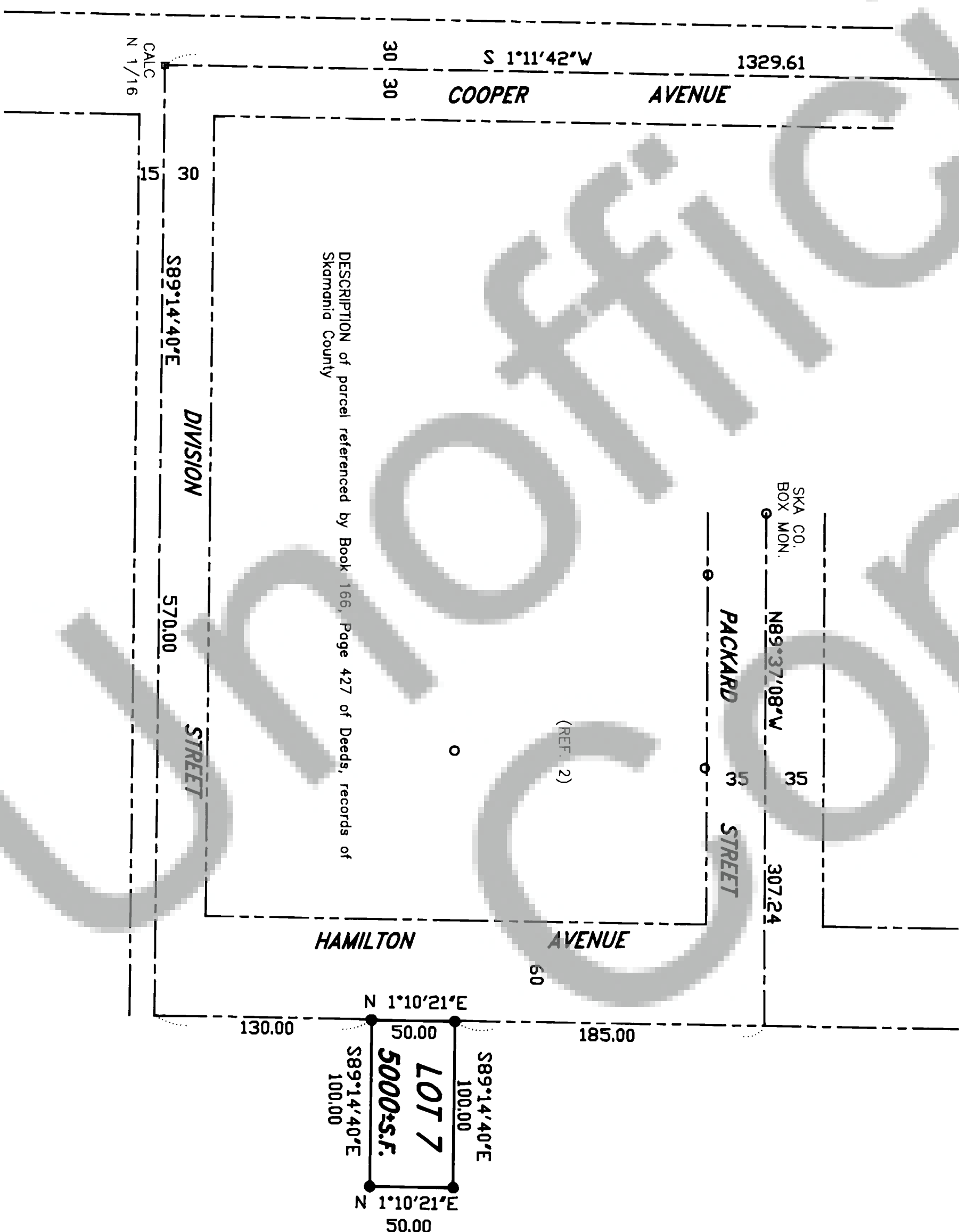
