Payment of a compensating tax equal to the difference between the amount of the assessed valuation on such land as forest land and the amount of the new assessed valuation of the land, multiplied by the daily rate of the last levy extended against the land, multiplied by the number of years (not to exceed 10) the land was classified as forest land.

I understand that the compensating tax and applicable interest becomes a lien on the land until fully satisfied.
