The credit agreement describing the repayment terms of the indebtedness, and any notes, agreements, or documents given to renew, extend or adjustment, renewal, or renegotiation.

2.4 Removal of Improvementa. Granter shall not demolish or remove any improvements from the Real Property without the prior written consent of Credit Union. 2.5 Credit Union's Right to Enter. Credit Union, its agents and representatives, may enter upon the Property at all reasonable times to attend to credit Union's interest and to inspect the Property.

2.6 Compliance with Governmental Requirements. Grantor shall promptly comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations of all governmental authorities applicable to the use or cost pancy of the Property. Grantor may contest in good faith any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold Union's interest in the Property is not jeopardized.

2.7 Outh of Protect. Grantor may do all other acts, allowed by law, that from the character and use of the Procenty are reasonably necessary.
