Any Borrower who cosigns this Deed of Trust, but does not execute the Agreement: (a) is cosigning this Deed of Trust only to grant and convey that Borrower's interest in the Property to Trustee under the terms of this Deed of Trust, (b) is not personally liable under the Agreement except as otherwise provided by law or contract; and (c) agrees that Credit Union and any other borrower hereunder may agree to extend, modify, forebear, release any coftateral, or make any other accommodations or amendments with regard to the terms of this Deed of Trust or the Agreement, without notice to that Borrower, without that Borrower's consent and without releasing that Borrower or modifying this Deed of Trust as to that Borrower's interest in the Property.

1. Rights and Obligations of Borrower, Borrower, Grantor has various rights and obligations under this Deed of Trust. These rights and responsibilities are set forth in the following paragraphs: 1. Payments and Performance; 2. Possession and Maintenance of Property; 3. Taxes and Liens; 4. Property Damage Insurance; 5. Expenditure by Credit Union, 7. Condemnation, 8.2. Remedies; 10.1. Consent by Credit Union, 10.2. Effect of Consent; 11. Security Agreement; Financing Statements; 14. Actions Upon Termination; 14.5. Attorneys Fees and Expenses; 16.2. Unit Ownership Power of Attorney; 16.3. Annual Reports; 16.5. Joint and Several Liability; 16.8. Waiver of Homestead Exemption, and 17.3. No Modifications.

1.1 Payment and Performance. Grantor shall pay to Credit Union all amounts secured by this Deed of Trust as they become due, and shall strictly perform all of Grantor's obligations.

2. Possession and Maintenance of the Property.

2.1 Possession. Until in default, Grantor may remain in possession and control of and operate and manage the Property and collect the Income from the Property.

- 2.2 Duty to Meintain. Grantor shall maintain the Property in first class condition and promptly perform all repairs and maintenance necessary to present its value.
- 2.3 Nulsance, Waste. Grantor shall neither conduct or permit any nuisance nor commit or suffer any strip or waste on or to the Property or any portion thereof including without limitation removal or alienation by Grantor of the right to remove any timber, minerals (including od and gas), or gravel or rock products. el or rock products.
- 2.4 Removal of Improvements. Grantor shall not demolish or remove any improvements from the Real Property without the prior written consent of Credit Union. Credit Union shall consent if Grantor makes arrangements satisfactory to Credit Union to replace any improvement which Grantor proposes to remove with one of at least equal value. "Improvements" shall include all existing and future buildings, structures, and parking facilities.
- 2.5 Credit Union's Right to Enter. Credit Union, its agents and representatives, may enter upon the Property at all reasonable times to attend to Credit Union's interest and to inspect the Property.

 2.6 Compilance with Governmental Requirements. Grantor shall promptly comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations of all governmental authorities applicable to the tise or occupancy of the Property. Grantor may contest in good faith any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Grantor has notified Credit Union in writing prior to doing so and Credit Union's interest in the Property is not jeopardized.

 2.7 Duty of Protect. Grantor may do all other acts, allowed by law, that from the character and use of the Property are reasonably necessary to protect and preserve the security.

 2.6 Construction Loan. If some or all of the proceeds of the loan creating the Indebtedness are to be used to construct or complete construction of any improvement on the Property, the Improvement shall be completed within six months from the date of this Deed of Trust and Grantor shall pay in this all costs and expenses in connection with the work.

 2.9 Hazardous Substances. Grantor represents and warrants that the Property has not been and will not be, during the period this deed remains a ten on the Property, used for the creation, manufacture, treatment, storage, or disposal of any hazardous substance, as defined in the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liabitity Act of 1980, and other applicable federal and state laws or regulations and amendments. Grantor authorizes Credit Union and its agents to enter upon the Property to make such inspections and tests as Credit Union may deem appropriate to determine compliance of the Property with this paragraph. Credit Union's inspections and tests shall be for Credit Union's purposes only and shall not be for the benefit or create any duty or liability to Grantor or any third party. Grantor agrees to indemnify and hold Credit Union harmless against any and all claims and losses including attorney fees resulting from a breach of this paragraph, which shall survive the payment of the indebtedness and satisfaction of this Deed of Trust.

 3. Taxes and Lifens.

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- 3. Taxes and Liens.

 3.1 Payment. Grantor shall pay when due before they become delinquent all taxes and assessments levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for work done on or for services rendered or material furnished to the Property. Grantor shall maintain the Property free of any tiens having priority over or equal to the interest of Credit Union under this Deed of Trust, except for he fier of taxes and assessments not due, except for he prior indebtedness referred to in Section 17, and except as otherwise provided in Subsection 3.2.

 3.2 Right to Contest. Grantor may withhold payment of any tax, assessment, or daim in connection with a good faith dispute over the obligation to pay, so long as Credit Union's interest in the Property is not jeopardized. If a lien arises or is filed as a result of nonpayment, Grantor shall within 15 days after the lien arises or, if a lien is filed, within 15 days after free frantor has notice of the filing, secure the discharge of the fien or deposit with Credit Union, cash or a sufficient corporate surely bond or other security satisfactory to Credit Union in an amount sufficient to discharge the lien plus any costs, attorneys's fees, or other charges that could accrue as a result of a foreclosure or sale under the lien.

 3.3 Evidence of Payment. Grantor shall upon demand furnish to Credit Union evidence of payment of the taxes or assessments and shall authorize the appropriate county official to deliver to Credit Union at least 15 days before any work is commenced, any services are furnished, or any materials are supplied to the Property if a construction fien could be asserted on account of the work, services, or materials, and the cost exceeds \$5,000 (if the Property is used for nonresidential or commercial purposes) or \$1,000 (if the Property is used as a residence). Grantor will on request furnish to Credit Union advance assurances satisfactory to Credit Union that Grantor can and will pay the cost of such Improvements.

 4.2 Application of Proceeds. Grantor shall promptly notify Credit Union of any loss or damage to the Property. Credit Union may make proof of loss if Grantor fails to do so within 15 days of the casualty. Credit Union may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the Indebtedness or the restoration and repair of the Property. If Credit Union elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repair or replace the damaged or destroyed Improvements in a manner satisfactory to Credit Union. Credit Union shall, upon satisfactory proof of such expenditure, pay or restoration and repair or the proceeds for the reasonable cost of repair or restoration if Grantor is not in default hereunder. Any proceeds which have not been paid out within 180 days after their receipt and which Credit Union has not committed to the repair or restoration of the Property such proceeds have proved the paid to Grantor.

(4) Grantor(s) are in default under any material obligation of the Agreement and Deed of Trust.

(5) The maximum annual percentage rate under the Agreement is reached.

(6) Any government action prevents Credit Union from imposing the annual percentage rate provided for or impairs Credit Union's security interest such that the value of the interest is less than 120 percent of the credit line.

(7) Credit Union has been notified by government agency that continued advances would constitute an unsare and unsound practice.

C. Change in Terms. The Agreement permits Credit Union to make certain changes to the terms of the Agreement at specified times or upon the occurrence of specified events.

14. Actions Upon Termination.

14.1 Remedies. Upon the occurrence of any termination and at any time thereafter, Trustee or Credit Union may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law:

(a) With respect to all or any part of the Real Property, the Trustee shall have the right to foreclose by judicial foreclosure, in either case in accordance with and to the full extent provided by applicable law. the Uniform Commercial Code in effect in the state in which the Credit Union shall have the right without notice to Grantor, to take possession of the Property and collect the Income, including amounts past due and unpaid, and apply the net proceeds, over and above Credit Union is located.

(c) Credit Union shall have the right, without notice to Grantor, to take possession of the Property and collect the Income, including credit Union may require any tenant or other user to make payments of rent of use fees directly to Credit Union i

(d) Credit Union shall have the right to have a receiver appointed to take possession of any or all of the Property, with the power to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the Property preceding foreclosure or sale, and to collect the income from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above cost of the receivership, against the Indebtedness. The receiver may serve without bond if permitted by law. Credit Union shall not disqualify a person from serving as a receiver.

Employment by Credit Union shall not disqualify a person from serving as a receiver.

(e) If Grantor remains in possession of the Property after the Property is sold as provided above or Credit Union otherwise becomes entitled to possession of the Property upon default of Grantor, Grantor shall become a tenant at will of Credit Union or the purchaser of the Property and shall pay white in possession a reasonable rental for use of the Property.

(f) If the Real Property is submitted to unit ownership, Credit Union or its designee may note on any matter that may come before the members of the association of unit owners, pursuant to the power of altomey granted Credit Union in Section 162.

(g) Trustee and Credit Union shall have any other right or remedy provided in this Deed of Trust, or the Note.

14.2 Sale of the Property. In exercising its rights and remedies, the Trustee or Credit Union, Shall be free to set all or any part of the Property and refrain from selling other portions. Credit Union shall be entitled to bid at any public sale on all or any portion of the Property.

14.3 Notice of Sele. Credit Union shall give Grantor reasonable notice of the time and place of any public sale of the Personal Property and refrain from selling other portions. Credit Union shall be entitled to bid at any public sale on all or any portion of the Sale or disposition.

14.4 Walver, Election of Remedies. A waiver by any party of a breach of a provision of this Deed of Trust shall not consistile a waiver of or prejudice the party's right otherw interest of the little as a straight fite cost of searching records, obtaining the reports (including forecostive reports), surveyors reports, appraisal fees, title insurance, and fees for the Trustee. Attorney fees include those for bankruptcy proceedings and anticipated post-judgment collection actions.

Any notice under this Deed of Trust shall be in writing and shall be effective when actually delivered or, if mailed, shall be deemed effective on the second day after being deposited as first-class registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, directed to the address stated in this Deed of Trust. Unless otherwise required by applicable law, any party may change its address for notices by written notice to the other parties. Credit Union requests that copies of notices of loredosure from the holder of any item which has priority over this Deed of Trust be sent to Credit Union address, as set forth on page one of this Deed of Trust. If the Property is in California, the notice shall be as provised by Section 2924b of the Civil Code of California. 16.1 Successors and Assigns. Credit Union, at Credit Union gotion, may from time to time appoint a successor trustee to any Trustee appointed hereunder by an instrument executed and acknowledged by Credit Union, and recorded in the office of the Recorder of the county where the Property is located. The instrument shall contain the name of the original Credit Union, Trustee, and Borrower, the book and page where this Deed of Trust is recorded, and the name and address of the successor trustee. The successor trustee shall, without conveyance of the Property, succeed to all the title, powers, and duties conferred upon the Trustee herein and by applicable law. This procedure for substitution of trustee shall govern to the exclusion of all other provisions for substitution.

16.11 Statement of Obligation. If the Property is in California, Credit Union may collect a fee not to exceed the statutory maximum for furnishing the statement of obligation as provided by Section 2943 of the Civil Code of California.

16.12 Severability, if any provision in this Deed of Trust shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the validity and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not in any way be affected or impaired.

17. Prior Indebtedness.
