  2.4 Removal of Improvements. Grantor shall not demolish or remove any improvements from the Real Property without the prior written consent of Credit Union. If a tien arises or is filed as a result of nonpayment, Grantor shall within 15 days after Grantor has notice of the fifting, secure the discharge of the fien or deposit with Credit Union, cash or a sufficient corporate surely bond or other security satisfactory to Credit Union in an amount sufficient to discharge the lien or deposit with costs, atomety's fees, or other charges that could accrue as a result of a foreclosure or sale under the lien.

(2) The value of Grantor's dwelling securing the Indebtedness declines significantly below its appraised value for purposes of the Agreement.

(3) Credit Union reasonably believes that Grantor will not be able to meet the repayment requirements of the Agreement due to a material change in Grantor's financial circumstances.

(4) Grantor(s) are in default under any material obligation of the Agreement and Deed of Trust.

(5) The maximum annual percentage rate under fine Agreement is reached.

(6) Any government action prevents Credit Union from imposing the annual percentage rate provided for or impairs Credit Union's security interest such that the value of the interest is tess than 120 percent of the credit line.

(7) Credit Union has been notified by government agency that continued advances would constitute an unsafe and unsound practice.

14. Actions Upon Termination.

14.1 Remedies. Upon the occurrence of any termination and at any time thereafter, Trustee or Credit Union may exercise any one or more of the toflowing rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law.
