





**TRAVERSE STATEMENT**

A closed traverse loop was made in 1996 generally following the exterior of the west half of the southwest of Section 15.  
Length 8481.58 feet. Freebalance accuracy 118411.  
Total angular error 0°01'45\" for 22 angles. Traverse balanced using least squares adjustment. A 3 second total station and related equipment was used for the survey, which meets Washington State Standards (WAC-332-130).
