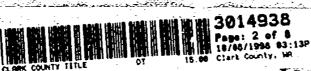
THIS DEED OF TRUST IS DATED 9/30/98. AMONG GAYLE I. FERGUSON, and , whose address is P.O. BOX 538/5 Russell St. STEVENSON, WA 98648 (referred to below as "Grantor"); Providence Health System Federal Credit Union whose address is 5050 NE Hoyt Insurance Company, whose address is 501 SE Columbia Shores Boulevard, Suite 500, Vancouver, Washington, 98661 (referred to below as "Trustoc").

1. CONVEYANCE AND GRANT. For valuable consideration, Grantor conveys to Trustee for the benefit of Lender as Beneficiary all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to the following-described real property, together with all existing or subsequently erected or affixed buildings, improvements and fixtures; all executents, rights of way, and appurtenances; all water, water rights and ditch rights (including stock in utilities with duch or irrigation rights); and all other rights, royalties, and profits relating to the real property, including, without limitation all minerals, oil, gas, geothermal and similar matters, located in Skamania County, State of Washington (the "Property"): See attached Exhibit A.

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Grantor also presently assigns to Lender (also known as Beneficiary in this Deed of Trust) all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to the Rents from the Property.

- DEFINITIONS. The following words shall have the following meanings when used in this Deed of Trust. Terms not otherwise defined
  in this Deed of Trust shall have the meanings attributed to such terms in the Wishington Uniform Commercial Code. All references to
  dellar amounts shall mean amounts in lawful money of the United States of America.
  - a) Improvements. The word "Improvements" means and includes without limitation all existing and future improvements, fixtures, buildings, structures, mobile homes affixed on the Property, facilities, additions and other construction on the Property.
  - b) Indebtedness. The word "Indebtedness" means all principal and interest payable under the Note and any amounts expended or advanced by Lender to discharge obligations of Grantor or expenses incurred by Trustee or Lender to enforce obligations of Grantor under this Deed of Trust, together with interest on such amounts as provided in this Deed of Trust.
  - e) Note. The word "Note" means the promissory note dated 9/30/98, in the principal amount of \$25,000.00 from Grantor to Lender, together with all renewals, extensions, modifications, refisancings, and substitutions for the Note. The rate of interest on the Note is subject to indexing, adjustment, renewal, or renegotiation.
  - d) Property. The word "Property" means the property, interests and rights described above in the "Conveyance and Grant" section.
  - e) Refated Documents. The words "Related Documents" means and include without limitation all promissory notes, credit agreements, loan agreements, guaranties, security agreements, mortgages, deeds of trust, and all other documents, whether now or hereafter existing, executed in connection with the Indebtedness.
  - f) Rents. The word "Rents" means all present and future rents, revenues, income, issues, royalties, profits, and other benefits derived from the Property.

THIS DEED OF TRUST, INCLUDING THE ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS, IS GIVEN TO SECURE (I) PAYMENT OF THE INDEBTEDNESS AND (2) PERFORMANCE OF ANY AND ALL OBLIGATIONS OF GRANTOR UNDER THE NOTE, THE RELATED DOCUMENTS, AND THIS DEED OF TRUST. THIS DEED OF TRUST IS GIVEN AND ACCEPTED ON THE FOLLOWING TERMS:

- PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE. Except as otherwise provided in this Deed of Trust, Grantor shall pay to Lender all amounts
  secured by this Deed of Trust as they become due, and shall strictly perform all of Grentor's obligations under the Note, this Deed of
  Trust, and any Related Documents.
- 4. POSSESSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PROPERTY. Grantor agrees that its possession and use of the Property shall be governed by the following provisions:
  - a) Passession and Use. Until the occurrence of an Event of Default, Grantor may (a) remain in possession and control of the Property, (b) operate and manage the Property, and (c) collect the Rens from the Property. The following provisions relate to the use of the Property or to other limitations on the Property. THIS INSTRUMENT WILL NOT ALLOW USE OF THE PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN THIS INSTRUMENT IN VIOLATION OF APPLICABLE LAND USE LAWS AND REGULATIONS. BEFORE SIGNING OR ACCEPTING THIS INSTRUMENT, THE PERSON ACQUIRING FEE TITLE TO THE PROPERTY SHOULD CHECK WITH THE APPROPRIATE CITY OR COUNTY PLANNING DEPARTMENT TO VERIFY APPROVED USES.
  - b) THE PROPERTY IS NOT USED FOR AGRICULTURAL OR FARMING PURPOSES.
  - c) Duty to Maintain. Grantor shall maintain the Property in good repair and promptly perform maintenance necessary to preserve its value.

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- d) Hazardous Substances. Grantor represents and warrants that the Property never will be so long as this Deed of Trust remains a lien on the Property, used for the generation, manufacture, storage, treatment, disposal, release or threatened release of any hazardous waste or substance, as those terms are defined in the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act of 1980, as amended, 42 U.S.C. Section 9601, et seq. ("CERCLA"), the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act ("SARA"), applicable state or Federal laws, or regulations adopted pursuant to any of the foregoing. Grantor authorizes Lender and its agents to enter upon the Property to make such inspections and tests as Lender may deem appropriate to determine compliance of the Property with this section of the Deed of Trust. Grantor hereby (a) releases and waives any future claims against Lender for indemnity or contribution in the event Grantor becomes liable for clearup or other costs under any such laws, and (b) agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Lender against any and all claims and losses resulting from a breach of this paragraph of the Deed of Trust.
- e) Natsaure, Waste. Grantor shall not cause, conduct or permit any nuisance nor commit or suffer any strip or waste on or to the Property. No building on the Property shall be altered, removed, or demolished without the prior written consent of Lender. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, Grantor will not remove, or grant to any other party the right to remove, any timber, minerals (including oil and gas), soil, gravel or rock products without the prior written or usent of Lender.
- 5. DUE ON SALE CONSENT BY LENDER. Lender may, at its option, declare immediately due and psyable all suchs secured by the Deed of Trust upon the sale or transfer, without the Lender's prior written consent, of all or any part of the Property, or any interest in the Property. A "sale or transfer" means the conveyance of Property or any right, title or interest therein; whether legal or equitable; whether voluntary or involuntary; whether by outright sale, deed, installment sale contract, land contract, contract for deed, leasehold interest with a term greater than three (3) years, lease-option contract, or by sale, assignment, or transfer of any be reficial interest in or to any land trust holding title to the Property, or by any other method of conveyance of Property interest. If any Grantor is a corporation or partnership, transfer also includes any charge in ownership of more than twenty-five (25%) of the voting stock or partnership interests, as the case may be, of Grantor. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if such exercise is prohibited by federal law or by Washington law.
- 6. TAXES AND LIENS. Grantor shall pay when due (and in all events prior to delinquency) all taxes, special taxes, assessments, charges (including water and sewer), fines and impositions levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for work done on or fer services rendered or material furnished to the Property. If the Property is entitled to exemption from property taxes, Borrower shall maintain that exemption in effect. Grantor shall maintain the Property free of all liens having priority over or equal to the interest of Lender under this Deed of Trust, except for the lien of taxes and assessments not due and except as otherwise provided in this Deed of Trust.
- 7. PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE. Grantor shall procure and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable value covering all improvements on the Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a standard mortgagee clause in favor of Lender, together with such other insurance, including but not limited to hazard, liability, business interruption, and boiler insurance, as Lender may reasonably require. Policies shall be written in form, amounts, coverages and basis reasonably acceptable to Lender and issued by a company or companies reasonably acceptable to Lender. Grantor, upon request of Lender, will deliver to Lender from time to time the policies or certificates of insurance in form satisfactory to Lender, including stipulations that coverages will not be cancelled or diminished without a least ten (10) days' prior written notice to Lender.

## WARNING

- 8. EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. If Grantor fails to comply with any provision of this Deed of Trust, or if any action or proceeding is commenced that would materially affect Lender's interest in the Property, Lender on Grantor's behalf may, but shall not be required to, take any action that Lender deems reasonably appropriate to protect its security interest in the Property. Any amount that Lender expends in so doing will bear interest at the rate charged under the Note from the date incurred or paid by Lender to the date of repayment by Grantor. All such expenses will be (a) payable on demand, (b) added to the balance of the Note and apportioned among and payable with any installment payments to become due during the remaining term of the Note, or (c) treated as a balkoon payment which will be due and payable at the Note's maturity. This Deed of Trust also will secure payment of these amounts. The rights provided for in this paragraph shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Lender may be entitled on account of the default. Any such action by Lender shall not be construed as curing the default so as to bar Lender from any remedy that it otherwise would have had.
- 9. WARRANTY; DEFENSE OF TITLE. The following provisions relating to ownership of the Property are a part of this Deed of Irust.
  - a) Title. Grantor warrants that (a) Grantor holds good and marketable title of record to the Property in fee simple, free and clear of all liens and encumbrances other than those set forth in the Property description or in any title insurance policy, title report, or final title opinion issued in favor of, and accepted by, Lender in connection with this Deed of Trust and (b) Grantor has the full right, power, and authority to execute and deliver this Deed of Trust to Lender.
  - Defense of Title. Subject to the exceptions in the paragraph above, Grantor warrants and will forever defend the title to the Property against the lawful claims of all persons.
- 10. CONDEMNATION. The following provisions relating to condemnation proceedings are a part of this Deed of Trust.
  - a) Application of Net Proceeds. If all or any part of the Property is condemned by eminent domain proceedings or by any proceeding or purchase in lieu of condemnation, Lender shall apply the net proceeds of the award to the repair or restoration of the Property, with any excess to be applied against the Indebtedness. The net proceeds of the award shall mean the award after payment of all reasonable costs, expenses, and attorneys' fees incurred by Trustee or Lender in connection with the condemnation.
  - b) Proceedings. If any proceeding in condemnation is filed, Grantor shall promptly notify Lender in writing, and Grantor shall promptly take such reasonable steps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the award. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding.
- 11. DEFAULT. Each of the following, at the option of Lender, shall constitute an event of default ("Event of Default") under this Deed of
  - Default on Indebtedness. Failure of Grantor to make any payment within fifteen (15) days of when due on the Indebtedness.
  - b) Default on Other Payments. Failure of Grantor within fifteen (15) days of the time required by this Deed of Trest to make any payments for times or insurance, or for any other payment necessary to prevent filing of or to effect discharge of any lien.
  - Compliance Default. Failure to comply with any other term, obligation, covenant or condition contained in this Deed of Trust, the Note or in any of the Related Documents, provided Grantor fails to cure said default within thirty (30) days after receiving notice of
  - Insolvency. The insolvency of Grantor, appointment of a receiver for any part of Grantor's property, any assignment for the benefit of creditors, the commencement of any proceeding under any bankruptcy or insolvency laws by or against Grantor, or the dissolution or termination of Grantor's existence as a going business (if Grantor is a business). Except to the extent prohibited by federal law or Washington law, the death of Grantor (if Grantor is an individual) also shall constitute an Event of Default under this

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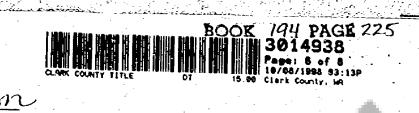
- e) Events Affecting Guarantor. Any of the preceding events occurs with respect to any Guarantor of any of the Indebtedness or such Guarantor dies or becomes incompetent.
- 12. RIGHTS AND REMEDIES ON DEFAULT. Upon the occurrence of any Event of Default and at any time thereafter, Trustee or Lender, at its option, may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law:
  - a) Accelerate Indebtedness. Lender shall have the right at its option to declare the entire Indebtedness immediately due and payable.
  - b) Foreclosure. With respect to all or any part of the Property, the Trustee shall have the right to foreclose by notice and sale, and Lender shall have the right to foreclose by judicial foreclosure, in either case in accordance with and to the full extent provided by applicable law. If this Deed of Trust is foreclosed by judicial foreclosure, to the extent allowed by law Lender will be entitled to a judgment which will provide that if the foreclosure sale proceeds are insufficient to satisfy the judgment, execution may issue for the amount of the unpaid balance of the judgment.
  - e) Other Remedies. Trustee or Lender shall have any other right or remedy provided in this Deed of Trust or the Note or by law.
  - d) Sale of the Property. To the extent permitted by applicable law, Grantor hereby waives any and all rights to have the Property marshalled. In exercising its rights and remedies, the Trustee or Lender shall be free to sell all or any part of the Property together or separately, in one sale or by separate sales. Bender shall be entitled to bid at any public sale on all or any portion of the Property.
  - e) Atterney Fees; Expenses. If Lender institutes any suit or action to enforce any of the terms of this Deed of Trust, Lender shall be entitled to recover such sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as intorrey fees at trial and on any appeal. Whether or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expenses incurred by Lender which in Lender's opinion are necessary at any time for the protection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the Indebtedness payable on demand and shall bear interest at the Note rate from the date of expenditure until repaid. Expenses covered by this paragraph include, without limitation, however subject to any limits under applicable law, Lender's attorneys' fees whether or not there is a lawsuit, including attorneys' fees for bankruptcy proceedings (including efforts to modify or vacate any automatic stay or injunction), appeals and any anticipated post-judgment collection services, the cost of searching records, obtaining title reports (including foreclosure reports), surveyors' reports, appraisal fees, title insurance, and fees for the Trustee, to the extent permitted by applicable law. Grantor also will pay any court costs, in addition to all other sums provided by law.
- 13. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS. The following miscellaneous provisions are a part of this Deed of Trust.
  - a) Applicable Law. This Deed of Trust has been delivered to Lender and accepted by Lender in the State of Washington. This Deed of Trust shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Washington.
  - b) Time is of the Essence. Time is of the essence in the performance of this Deed of Trust.
  - c) Walvern and Consents. Lender shall not be deemed to have waived any rights under this Deed of Trust (or under the Related Documents) unless such waiver is in writing and signed by Lender. No delay or omission on the party of Lender in exercising any right shall operate as a waiver of such right or any other right. A waiver by any party of a provision of this Deed of Trust shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's right otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. No prior waiver by Lender, nor any course of dealing between Lender and Grantor, shall constitute a waiver of any of Lender's rights or any of Grantor's obligations as to any future transactions. Whenever coesent by Lender is required in this Deed of Trust, the granting of such consent by Lender in any instance shall not constitute continuing consent to subsequent instances where such consent is required.

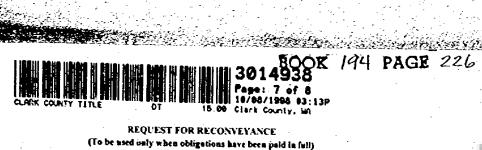
