Lou,

Enclosed is our check # 15 38 in the amount of \$2225 which, according to the SLOA BoT's most recent assessment, is our total, full and fival payment on the SLOA Dock replacement and Dam repair projects.

I must inform you that we are paying this \$2225 assessment under duress and protest for at least two reasons. First, I believe that the correct amount of this final payment should be no more than \$1380 (based upon the spending Cap requested by the board and approved by the membership in 1996). And secondly, I note that, I have received no response from you on either of my two requests, dated 27 July and 21 September 1999, which asked for a confidential meeting concerning this payment as outlined in your offers and that of your representative to meet with any member who requests it.

We are basing our submission of this payment upon assurances made by the board of trustees of the accuracy and legality of the demand for payment and that this will be the FINAL and complete payment of the assessment for these projects and that any funds not used for the dock/dam projects will be returned to the membership.

Since the summer of 1995 much has been said, pro and con, over the handling of these projects by members of various persuasions. Again, I would remind you that I know of no one who objects to the completion of these projects -- only to the way they have been administered. The most fitting words I know of appear on a memorial to those who worked diligently to save Wasco County, Oregon from the Rashneesh: "The only thing necessary for the triumph of evil is for good men to do nothing."

Deer Mr. and Mrs. Backstrand:

Receipt of your letter of October 15, 1999 is ecknowledged in addition to your check in the amount of \$2,222.00. For the reasons stated below, we are returning your check with this letter, and we ask that you resubmit your check without conditions or restrictions attached.

Our attorney has advised us that a check tendered with conditions attached, either on the face of the check or by separate letter, is subject to RCW 62A.3-311. He has further advised us that if we accept your check as submitted, we may later be deemed to have accepted some or all of the terms contained in your letter of October 15, 1999. Put simply, we are not willing to accept payment submitted under those conditions.

We acknowledge that you are paying your assessment under protest and accept that fact. We also acknowledge that you object to the proposed Dam project for a variety of reasons as explained in your letter. We disagree that the Board or Association have taken any improper action, and we are unwilling to accept your conditions and elipulations as proposed.

We urge you to resubmit your check without conditions attached. If you do so within 10 days of the date of this letter, we agree to waive any interest that may otherwise be due as a result of delayed payment. If you fell to pay in a timely manner, we will seek available remedies as allowed under Washington law.
