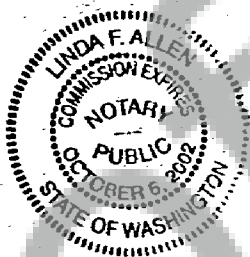

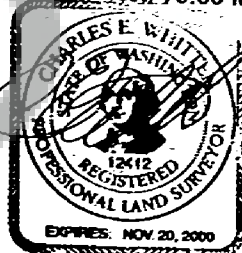

A 50-foot right-of-way and 25-foot temporary construction right-of-way over and across a portion of Government Lot 9, Section 16, Township 2 North, Range 7 East, Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington, described as follows:

That portion of the original right-of-way granted to Pacific Northwest Pipeline Corporation as described in Book 73 of Deeds, Pages 153-155, Skamania County Deed Records, that lies Southwesterly of the following described line:

BEGINNING at a concrete monument marked "NB 68" as shown on the "Second Addition to the Plats of Relocated North Bonneville" at the intersection of the West line of the B.B. Bishop Donation Land Claim with the South line of a 300 foot Bonneville Power Administration right-of-way, said monument being 881.58 feet South and 664.44 feet West of a 1 inch iron pipe at the witness corner located 114.72 feet North of the corner common to Sections 16, 17, 20 and 21; thence North $02^{\circ} 05' 29''$ East, along the West line of the B.B. Bishop D.L.C., 2382.89 feet to a 1 inch iron pipe at the Northwest corner of the B.B. Bishop D.L.C. (as it existed in June, 1976); thence North $86^{\circ} 20' 38''$ East, 618.85 feet to a 1/2 inch iron pipe at the intersection of the North line of the B.B.
