Harry B. Fay, the Personal Representative of this estate, makes this peclar on of Completion of Probate.

Daniel Jerome Danielson ("Decedent") died intestate on April 13, 1994. At the time of his death his closest known relatives were his mother, Hazel Brunstrom, and his sister, Patricia Ann Grant, residents of the State of California.

At the time of Decedent's death his business and property affairs were being managed by his accountant and business associate, Douglas O'Connor, CPA, of Snohomish, Washington. Decedent had been suffering from terminal cancer several. years prior to his death. Under the circumstances, management of Decedent's businesses and properties was best kept with Mr O'Connor, and Decedent's mother and sister made their respective Waivers of Right to Act as Personal Representative and Consents to Order of Solvency on April 27, 1994. Several months after his appointment as Personal Representative, Mr O'Connor investigated the status of two children known to have been borne to the Decedent, namely Thomas Eric Danielson, born July 2, 1962 and Cynthia Rae Danielson-Madden born November 21, 1959. Mr O'Connor knew of these two children, but had been told they were adopted by their once step-father, Thomas Joseph Hatty, the husband of their mother, Judith Elaine Cignetti, who had been married to Decedent when the children were born. The said son and daughter are the true heirs to the Decedent, and filed with this Declaration in support thereof are the affidavits of Judith Elaine Cignetti, their mother and the former wife of the Decedent, Mary L. Beason, their grandmother, the mother of Judith Cignetti, Janet Irnetz Parker and Thomas Welborn Parker, the sister and brother-in-law of Judith Cignetti, and the aunt and uncle of Tom Danielson and Cythia Danielson-Madden.

Approximately a year after Decedent's death there was discovered hazardous material and environmental pollution on the business property located in the Maple Valley area. As a result litigation ensued, and the suits (filed in 1996 and 1997) were ultimately resolved in 1998 and 1999 with settlements following substantial discovery, depositions, insurance claims, engineering studies and environmental investigations.

No creditor's claims were filed, the publication of Notice to Creditors having been issued in May, 1994.

1994, 1995 and 1997. The final return for the estate was 1999, and the estimated tax has been paid for 1999.

The accounting of the Personal Representative undersigned has been completed and copies thereof provided to the two heirs, Tom Danielson and Cindy Madden. The remaining undistributed portions of the estate consist of the balances owed by the purchasers of the two parcels of real estate, which contracts provide monthly installments of \$630.00 and \$2,400.00 on the sales of the residence and the equipment rental business properties, respectfully.
