II. ORDER AND JUDGMENT



ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that plaintiff have and is hereby granted judgment against defendants, MARY SMITH and JOHN DOE SMITH and their marital community, jointly and severally, in the principal amount of \$2,648.04, plus interest of \$655.13, court costs and disbursements totalling \$150.00, and Reasonable attorneys' fees of \$750.00, for a total judgment of \$4,203.17.
